AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND ORDINANCE 1660-2019 “MAKE APPROPRIATIONS FOR CURRENT EXPENSES AND OTHER EXPENDITURES OF THE VILLAGE OF LAKEMORE, STATE OF OHIO. DURING THE FISCAL YEAR ENDING DECEMBER 31, 2020”

Now, Therefore, Be it Ordained by the Council of the Village of Lakemore, County of Summit, State of Ohio:


- Section 1: Council approves to increase appropriations in:  
General Fund Transfers Out \$52,000.00 to transfer funds for the storm sewer work on Lakeview Street and Lakeside Drive  
Storm Sewer Professional \$52,000.00 to afford the storm sewer work on Lakeview Street and Lakeside Drive  
**Amended to include: Water Enterprise \$12,700.00 to afford work by Hammontree and Associates**  
**General Fund Land and Buildings \$79,000.00 to purchase four parcels referenced in Ordinance 1666-2020**  
**Bond Retirement \$39,000.00 to afford vehicle loan payments to USDA**
- Section 2: Council approves to increase Revenues in Storm Sewer Fund Transfers In \$52,000.00 to afford storm sewer work  
**Amended to include: Bond Retirement Transfers In \$39,000.00**
- Section 3: Treasury for payments from any of the forgoing appropriations upon receiving proper certificates and vouchers therefore, approved by the board or officers authorized by law to approve the same, or an ordinance or resolution of Council to make the expenditures; provided that no warrants shall be drawn or paid for salaries or wages except to persons employed by authority of and in accordance with law or ordinance. It shall be provided further that the appropriations for contingencies can only be expended upon appeal of two-thirds vote of Council for items of expense constituting a legal obligation against the village for purposes other than those covered by other specific appropriations herein made.
- Section 4: This Ordinance shall go into effect on and after the earliest period allowed by law.



**A RESOLUTION ALLOWING THE MAYOR TO APPLY FOR CONNECTING COMMUNITIES PLANNING GRANT FUNDS PROGRAMMED BY THE AKRON METROPOLITAN AREA TRANSPORTATION STUDY (AMATS) TO CONSTRUCT “LIVING IN LAKEMORE” SIDEWALK PLANNING STUDY AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY**

**WHEREAS**, pedestrian travel is difficult without sidewalks through the community; and

**WHEREAS**, the need to improve health and ease of safe pedestrian travel is a priority for the Village of Lakemore Mayor and Council; and

**WHEREAS**, Village of Lakemore Mayor and Council have created the “Living in Lakemore” initiative that is in need of funding for engineering a sidewalk planning study.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** by the Council of the Village of Lakemore, County of Summit, State of Ohio:

**SECTION 1.** That the Mayor is hereby authorized to apply for Connecting Communities Planning Grant Funds programmed by the Akron Metropolitan Area Transportation Study (AMATS) for the following “Living in Lakemore” sidewalk planning study. This study will help the Village of Lakemore create a plan for locating sidewalks in the community to provide pedestrians with a safe mode of travel. The estimated cost of the study is \$15,000.00. The Village of Lakemore is requesting \$12,000.00 from the AMATS funding and is affording \$3,000.00 matching funds.

**SECTION 2.** That the Village of Lakemore acknowledges and understands the AMATS “Funding Policy Guidelines” and confirms to the best of its knowledge that the information contained in the project application is accurate, that it intends to diligently pursue that project, and that a local share will be provided.

**SECTION 3.** That it is hereby found and determined that all formal actions of the Council concerning and relating to the passage of this Resolution were taken in an open meeting of this Council and that all deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal action were meeting open to the public and in compliance with the law.

**SECTION 4.** This Resolution is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, safety convenience and welfare of the Village of Lakemore Council and the inhabitants thereof, for the reason that it is to apply for this funding within the next ten days, and provided that it receives the approval of two-thirds of the members of Council, shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage and approval; otherwise to be in full force and effect from and after the earliest period allowed by law.

by law.


