LAKEMORE FIRE DEPARTMENT


Now Therefore, Be it Resolved by the Council of the Village of Lakemore, County of Summit, and State of Ohio:

- Section 1: Because Springfield Lake continues to be affected by Cyanotoxins, making the lake unsafe for recreational use, the Village of Lakemore will not install boat docks for 2020. Furthermore, the Village of Lakemore will not encourage any recreational use of Springfield Lake for 2020.
- Section 2: Subsequently, any recreational use of the launch at Lakemore's Dodds Lakefront Park or Springfield Lake will be considered "at own risk".
- Section 3: This Resolution is declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public health, safety, and welfare of the citizens of the Village of Lakemore. 

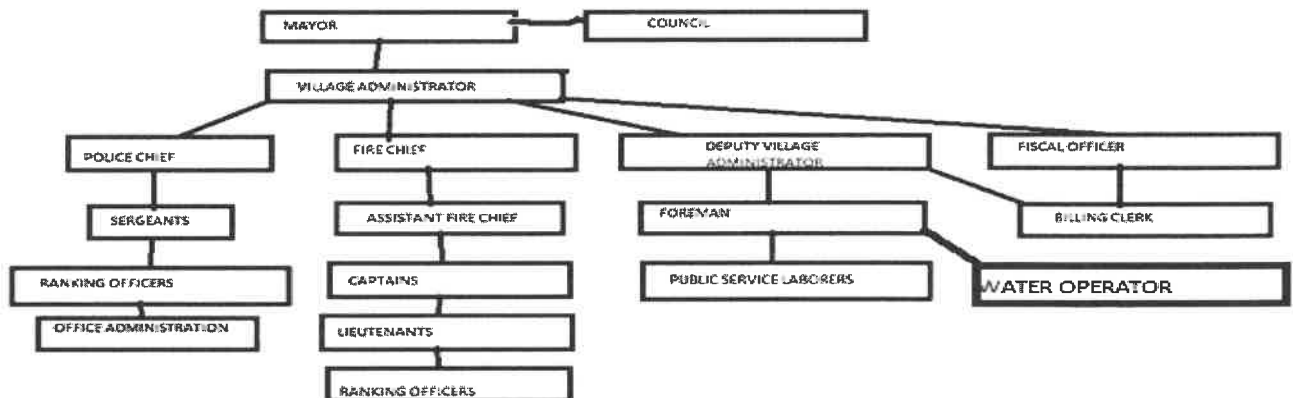

Now, Therefore, Be it Ordained by the Council of the Village of Lakemore, County of Summit, State of Ohio:

Section 1: Council approves to increase appropriations in:
General Fund Transfers Out \$5,460.00 to afford storm sewer work at dead end of Seneca Avenue.
Storm Sewer Fund \$5,460.00 to afford storm sewer work at dead end of Seneca Avenue.

Section 2: Council approves to increase Revenues in:
Storm Sewer Fund Tranfers In \$5,460.00 to afford storm sewer work at dead end of Seneca Avenue.

Section 3: Treasury for payments from any of the forgoing appropriations upon receiving proper certificates and vouchers therefore, approved by the board or officers authorized by law to approve the same, or an ordinance or resolution of Council to make the expenditures; provided that no warrants shall be drawn or paid for salaries or wages except to persons employed by authority of and in accordance with law or ordinance. It shall be provided further that the appropriations for contingencies can only be expended upon appeal of two-thirds vote of Council for items of expense constituting a legal obligation against the village for purposes other than those covered by other specific appropriations herein made.

Section 4: This Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the health, safety, and welfare of the citizens of the Village of Lakemore, Ohio. Therefore, this Ordinance shall go into effect immediately.
