MINUTES FOR COUNCIL MEETING
JUNE 1, 2020

Meeting Called to Order by Mayor Cole at 7:00 p.m.

Opening Roll Call: Mrs. Coontz, Mrs. Cochran, Ms. Snyder, Mr. Strittmatter, Ms. Anderson, and Mr. Douglas were present.

Pledge of Allegiance was led by Mayor Cole.

Motion to Accept minutes from May 18, 2020 council meeting as presented and not read was made by Ms. Anderson and seconded by Mr. Strittmatter. Roll call: Mrs. Cochran, Ms. Snyder, Mr. Strittmatter, Ms. Anderson, Mr. Douglas, Mrs. Coontz voted “yes”. Motion carried.

Motion to Accept Purchase Orders from May 18, 2020 to May 29, 2020, totaling \$67,836.85 as presented and not read was made by Mrs. Cochran and seconded by Ms. Anderson. Roll call: Ms. Snyder, Mr. Strittmatter, Ms. Anderson, Mr. Douglas, Mrs. Coontz, Mrs. Cochran voted “yes”. Motion carried.

Motion to Accept Bills from May 18, 2020 to May 29, 2020, totaling \$83,429.24 as presented and not read was made by Mr. Strittmatter and seconded by Mrs. Cochran. Roll call: Mr. Strittmatter, Ms. Anderson, Mr. Douglas, Mrs. Coontz, Mrs. Cochran, Ms. Snyder voted “yes”. Motion carried.

Motion to Accept April 2020 EMS Billing and Collection reports was made by Mr. Strittmatter and seconded by Ms. Anderson. Roll call: Ms. Anderson, Mr. Douglas, Mrs. Coontz, Mrs. Cochran, Ms. Snyder, Mr. Strittmatter voted “yes”. Motion carried.

Mrs. Coontz announced the first day of summer lunches was June 1st. The meals are available to all Lakemore and Springfield residents with children between 11 and noon Monday through Friday.

Mrs. Cochran reported she spoke with Chief Ray regarding the recent protesting and luting in the suburbs of Akron. Chief Ray has increased staffing. Chief Ray has asked all to leave lights on outside at night to provide additional security. He does not feel there are any threats to Lakemore.

Ms. Snyder announced the next council meetings will be Monday, June 15, 2020 and July 6, 2020, both at 7:00 p.m.

Ms. Snyder reminded garden plot applications are available.

Mr. Strittmatter announced the next council workshops will be June 10th and June 23rd at 6:00 p.m.
