MINUTES FOR COUNCIL MEETING
JUNE 15, 2020

Meeting was Called to Order by Mayor Cole at 7:00 p.m.

Opening Roll Call: Mrs. Coontz, Mrs. Cochran, Ms. Snyder, Mr. Strittmatter, Ms. Anderson, and Mr. Douglas were present.

Pledge of Allegiance was led by Mayor Cole.

Motion to Accept minutes from June 1, 2020 council meeting as presented and not read was made by Mr. Douglas and seconded by Ms. Anderson. Roll call: Mrs. Cochran, Ms. Snyder, Mr. Strittmatter, Ms. Anderson, Mr. Douglas, and Mrs. Coontz. Motion carried.

Motion to Accept Purchase Orders from May 29, 2020 to June 13, 2020, totaling \$10,552.80 as presented and not read was made by Ms. Anderson and seconded by Mr. Douglas. Roll call: Ms. Snyder, Mr. Strittmatter, Ms. Anderson, Mr. Douglas, Mrs. Coontz, and Mrs. Cochran. Motion carried.

Council Report

Mrs. Coontz announced free breakfasts and lunches are still provided to families with children, Monday through Friday between 11:00 a.m. and noon at the Lakemore Municipal Building and Springhill Elementary.

Mrs. Cochran thanked Pastor Gindlesberger and staff for providing an area for Village meetings.

Mrs. Cochran announced the Village is proactively processing any nuisance properties.

Ms. Snyder announced garden spots are still available at the community garden. Applications are online and at the municipal building.

Mr. Strittmatter announced the next council meetings will be Monday, July 6, 2020, and July 20, 2020, both at 7:00 p.m. The next council workshops will be June 23rd and July 15th at 6:00 p.m.

Mr. Strittmatter thanked the resident who cleaned and tilled the remaining plots at the community garden.

Ms. Anderson reminded everyone to fill out their census.

Ms. Anderson reminded everyone to report they live in Lakemore when renewing tags so the Village will receive the permissive taxes for road improvements.

Mr. Douglas announced five counties filed class action suits for commanding certain facilities to remain closed during the COVID-19 lockdown.

Ms. Fast announced the Village has provided information on the website, on NextDoor, and on the upcoming water quality report on ways residents can help improve the health of the lake.

Ms. Fast announced she has met with experts, our engineers at Hammontree, and the Mayor to coordinate a plan of improvement for the health of the lake.
