AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND ORDINANCE 1660-2019 “MAKE APPROPRIATIONS FOR CURRENT EXPENSES AND OTHER EXPENDITURES OF THE VILLAGE OF LAKEMORE, STATE OF OHIO. DURING THE FISCAL YEAR ENDING DECEMBER 31, 2020”

Now, Therefore, Be it Ordained by the Council of the Village of Lakemore, County of Summit, State of Ohio:

Section 1: Council approves to increase appropriations in:
General Fund Police Professional Services for 2019 Prosecutorial Services \$16,403.63
General Fund Cultural Recreational Professional Services for lighting improvements at Upper Wateworks and Dodds Park afforded by NOPEC grant \$13,100.00
General Fund Cultural Recreational Professional Services to have 13 trees removed at parks and trimmed \$8150.00
General Fund Land and Building Telephones \$6200.00 to order and install phones and internet through AT&T
Local Corona Relief Fund \$152,980.22 for payroll of safety services afforded through HB 481 grant

Section 2: Council approves to increase Revenues in:
General Fund Other Intergovernmental for NOPEC grant \$10,606.00
General Fund Other Intergovernmental for reimbursement from SUMM-013C grant of \$49,000.00
Local Corona Relief Fund \$152,980.22 from HB 481 grant

Section 3: Treasury for payments from any of the forgoing appropriations upon receiving proper certificates and vouchers therefore, approved by the board or officers authorized by law to approve the same, or an ordinance or resolution of Council to make the expenditures; provided that no warrants shall be drawn or paid for salaries or wages except to persons employed by authority of and in accordance with law or ordinance. It shall be provided further that the appropriations for contingencies can only be expended upon appeal of two-thirds vote of Council for items of expense constituting a legal obligation against the village for purposes other than those covered by other specific appropriations herein made.

Section 4: This Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the health, safety, and welfare of the citizens of the Village of Lakemore, Ohio, for the reason that the appropriation is necessary for the continued

operation of the Village of Lakemore. Therefore, this Ordinance shall go into effect immediately.
