A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR AND VILLAGE SOLICITOR TO ENTER INTO AN AGREEMENT WITH THE CITY OF GREEN, OHIO FOR FIRE DISPATCHING SERVICES

Now Therefore, Be it Resolved by the Council of the Village of Lakemore, County of Summit, and State of Ohio:

Section 1: That the Mayor and Village Solicitor are authorized to enter into an agreement with the City of Green, Ohio for Fire Dispatching Services. This agreement will be for a period commencing January 1, 2020, and ending December 31, 2022.

Section 2: The City of Green, Ohio will provide emergency fire and medical dispatching service to Lakemore for calls which are received by the City of Green, Ohio which originate in the Village of Lakemore on a twenty-four (24) hour, seven (7) day-per-week basis.


Section 3: A copy of this agreement is attached hereto and made part hereof as if fully rewritten herein.

Section 4: This Resolution is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the health, safety, and welfare of the citizens of the Village of Lakemore, Ohio, as the service is necessary for the continued operation of the Village of Lakemore Fire Department. Therefore, this Resolution shall go into effect immediately.





ORDINANCE NO 1686-2020

AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND ORDINANCE 1660-2019 "MAKE APPROPRIATIONS FOR CURRENT EXPENSES AND OTHER EXPENDITURES OF THE VILLAGE OF LAKEMORE, STATE OF OHIO. DURING THE FISCAL YEAR ENDING DECEMBER 31, 2020"

Now, Therefore, Be it Ordained by the Council of the Village of Lakemore, County of Summit, State of Ohio:

Section 1: Council approves to increase appropriations in:
General Fund Transfers Out \$13,000.00 to afford elimination of old storm pipe running to Springfield Lake per engineer's estimate.

Water Enterprise Fund \$23,000.00 to afford the connection of two dead end water lines of Church Street and Lake Road per engineer's estimate.

Storm Sewer Fund \$13,000.00 to afford the elimination of old storm pipe running to Springfield lake per engineer's estimate.

Section 2: Council approves to increase Revenues in:
Storm Sewer Fund Tranfers In \$13,000.00 to afford elimination of old storm pipe running to Springfield Lake per engineer's estimate.

Section 3: Treasury for payments from any of the forgoing appropriations upon receiving proper certificates and vouchers therefore, approved by the board or officers authorized by law to approve the same, or an ordinance or resolution of Council to make the expenditures; provided that no warrants shall be drawn or paid for salaries or wages except to persons employed by authority of and in accordance with law or ordinance. It shall be provided further that the appropriations for contingencies can only be expended upon appeal of two-thirds vote of Council for items of expense constituting a legal obligation against the village for purposes other than those covered by other specific appropriations herein made.

Section 4: This Ordinance shall go into effect on and after the earliest period allowed by law.
