

THE VILLAGE OF LAKEMORE
MINUTES FOR COUNCIL MEETING
JULY 20, 2020

Meeting Was Called to Order by Mayor Cole at 7:00 p.m.

Opening Roll Call: Mrs. Coontz, Mrs. Cochran, Ms. Snyder, Mr. Strittmatter, Ms. Anderson, and Mr. Douglas were present.

Pledge of Allegiance Was Led by Mayor Cole.

Motion to Accept minutes from July 6, 2020 council meeting as presented and not read was made by Mr. Douglas and seconded by Mr. Strittmatter. Roll call: Mrs. Cochran, Ms. Snyder, Mr. Strittmatter, Ms. Anderson, Mr. Douglas, and Mrs. Coontz voted “yes”. Motion carried.

Motion to Accept Purchase Orders from July 4, 2020 to July 17 2020 totaling \$147,792.27 as presented and not read was made by Mr. Strittmatter and seconded by Mrs. Cochran. Roll call: Ms. Snyder, Mr. Strittmatter, Ms. Anderson, Mr. Douglas, Mrs. Coontz, and Mrs. Cochran voted “yes”. Motion carried.

Motion to Accept Bills from July 4, 2020 to July 17 2020, totaling \$126,414.05 as presented and not read was made by Mrs. Cochran and seconded by Ms. Anderson. Roll call: Mr. Strittmatter, Ms. Anderson, Mr. Douglas, Mrs. Coontz, Mrs. Cochran, and Ms. Snyder voted “yes”. Motion carried.

Motion to Accept 2020 Employees’ Leaves report as presented and not read was made by Mr. Strittmatter and seconded by Ms. Anderson. Roll call: Ms. Anderson, Mr. Douglas, Mrs. Coontz, Mrs. Cochran, Ms. Snyder, and Mr. Strittmatter voted “yes”. Motion carried.

Mayor’s Report

Mayor Cole explained the mis-representations from the media regarding the Village of Lakemore and Springfield Lake. A tentative, in-person meeting between Springfield Township and the Village of Lakemore was cancelled because of the COVID19

restrictions. The scheduling of a virtual meeting is possible. The Village of Lakemore has contacted the Medina County parks officials to get more information on the Algae Blue chemicals used in Chippewa Lake.

Mayor Cole announced the next Lakemore United Methodist Church food pantry will be Wednesday, July 29, 2020.

Council Report

Mrs. Coontz announced lunches are still provided by Springfield Local Schools at the Lakemore Municipal Building Monday through Friday between 11 a.m. and noon to anyone with children.

Mrs. Cochran thanked Mr. Krunich to allowing the Village Council to meet at the Springfield Lake Roller Rink.

Mrs. Cochran updated the status of the nuisance abatement hearings. Any costs incurred by the Village of Lakemore to rectify the zoning nuisances will be assessed to the properties. More hearings are planned.

Mrs. Cochran announced the Village of Lakemore is enforcing the zoning for pools and fences to ensure the safety of the children in the community.

Ms. Snyder announced the next council meetings will be Monday, August 3, 2020 and August 17, 2020, both at 7:00 p.m.

Ms. Snyder announced the next council workshops will be July 28th and August 12th at 6:00 p.m.

Mr. Strittmatter announced LFD in c/o with American Red Cross Blood Drive Thursday, July 30, 2020 between noon and 6:00 p.m. at the Municipal Building.

Mr. Strittmatter reminded everyone there is information on website how residents can help improve the health of the lake. He explained the health of Springfield Lake declined over a very long period of time, so repairing the damage will also take time.

Ms. Anderson reminded everyone to fill out their census. The census dictates amounts of grant monies a community will receive.

Ms. Anderson reminded everyone to mention Lakemore when renewing tags to ensure Village receives permissive tax money to repair roads.

Zoning – Processing nuisance abatements, enforcing for fences with pools for safety of community

Mr. Douglas reminded everyone owning small businesses to re-apply for financial assistance for those impacted by COVID-19.

New Business:

Mr. Strittmatter made a motion to adopt Resolution 6984-2020. Ms. Snyder seconded the motion. Roll call: Mr. Strittmatter, Ms. Anderson, Mr. Douglas, Mrs. Coontz, Mrs. Cochran, and Ms. Snyder voted "yes". Resolution adopted.

Mr. Strittmatter made a motion to dispense with the three readings of Ordinance 1686-2020. Mrs. Cochran seconded the motion. Roll call: Ms. Anderson, Mr. Douglas, Mrs. Coontz, Mrs. Cochran, Ms. Snyder, and Mr. Strittmatter voted "yes". Motion carried.

Mr. Strittmatter made a motion to adopt Ordinance 1686-2020. Ms. Anderson seconded the motion. Mr. Douglas asked why funds were being appropriated in the General fund and Storm Sewer fund for the same work. Ms. Fast explained the funds appropriated in the General fund were to transfer to the Storm Sewer fund. Then the new funds transferred must be appropriated to spend from the Storm Sewer fund. Roll call: Mr. Douglas, Mrs. Coontz, Mrs. Cochran, Ms. Snyder, Mr. Strittmatter, and Ms. Anderson voted "yes". Ordinance adopted.

Motion to Adjourn was made by Ms. Anderson and seconded by Mr. Douglas. Roll call: Mrs. Coontz, Mrs. Cochran, Ms. Snyder, Mr. Strittmatter, Ms. Anderson, and Mr. Douglas voted "yes". Meeting adjourned at 7:25 p.m.
