

THE VILLAGE OF LAKEMORE  
MINUTES FOR COUNCIL MEETING  
AUGUST 3, 2020

Meeting Was Called to Order by Mayor Cole at 7:00 p.m.

Opening Roll Call: Mrs. Coontz, Mrs. Cochran, Ms. Snyder, Mr. Strittmatter, Ms. Anderson, and Mr. Douglas were present.

Pledge of Allegiance Was Led by Mayor Cole.

Motion to Accept minutes from July 20, 2020 council meeting as presented and not read was made by Mr. Strittmatter and seconded by Mr. Douglas. Roll call: Mrs. Cochran, Ms. Snyder, Mr. Strittmatter, Ms. Anderson, Mr. Douglas, and Mrs. Coontz voted “yes”. Motion carried.

Motion to Accept Purchase Orders from July 18, 2020 to July 31, 2020 totaling \$36,470.00 as presented and not read was made by Mrs. Cochran and seconded by Mr. Douglas. Roll call: Ms. Snyder, Mr. Strittmatter, Ms. Anderson, Mr. Douglas, Mrs. Coontz, and Mrs. Cochran voted “yes”. Motion carried.

Motion to Accept Bills from July 18, 2020 to July 31, 2020, totaling \$204,793.04 as presented and not read was made by Ms. Anderson and seconded by Mrs. Cochran. Roll call: Mr. Strittmatter, Ms. Anderson, Mr. Douglas, Mrs. Coontz, Mrs. Cochran, and Ms. Snyder voted “yes”. Motion carried.

Motion to Accept June 2020 EMS billings and collections report as presented and not read was made by Mr. Strittmatter and seconded by Mrs. Cochran. Roll call: Ms. Anderson, Mr. Douglas, Mrs. Coontz, Mrs. Cochran, Ms. Snyder, and Mr. Strittmatter voted “yes”. Motion carried.

### **Mayor’s Report**

Mayor Cole explained 1. Members of Springfield Township had taken water samples from the “point” to test for e-coli however did so at spots not for their geese and duck population density. 2. That storm and sanitary sewers are not combined in Lakemore and are laid such that the sanitary sewer line rests below the storm line. 3. Storm lines get backed up and over saturate the ground as well as into the sanitary lines, especially when the level of the lake is higher than recommended. And Finally the Village is in the process of gaining camera, smoke or dye tests to find any leaks so we can fix them appropriately.

Mrs. Coontz announced special election on August 4, for the school levy

Mr. Strittmatter reminded everyone there is information on our website residents can use to improve the health of the lake and also to find any information for COVID assistance.

Mr. Strittmatter announced that he met with Springfield Township on August 1st to show some of Springfield residents where Springfield had pipes leading to the lake.

Ms. Anderson reminded everyone about the hours the mayor spends explaining the situation involving the lake and to dispel misinformation people may have. She encouraged any Springfield residents listening to contact their trustees for information as well.

Ms. Anderson reminded everyone to mention Lakemore when renewing tags to ensure the Village receives permissive tax money to repair roads.

Mr. Douglas reminded Springfield Township of the option to use the Algae Blue and that they can call TD for more information.
