Now Therefore Be it Resolved by the Council of the Village of Lakemore, County of Summit, State of Ohio:

- SECTION 1. The Mayor, on behalf of the Village of Lakemore, Ohio, is hereby authorized to make improvements with the Sanitarium Road Drainage and Resurfacing project.
- SECTION 2. This project is funded with grants and loans from Ohio Public Works Commission.
- SECTION 3. That the Mayor, on behalf of the Village of Lakemore, Ohio, is authorized to review bids, enter into any agreements, and execute contracts as may be necessary.
- SECTION 4. That it is hereby found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the passage of this resolution were adopted in an open meeting of this Council and that all deliberations of this Council or any of its committees that resulted in such formal actions were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.
- SECTION 5. This Resolution is declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public health, safety, and welfare of the citizens of the Village of Lakemore. Therefore, this Resolution shall take effect immediately.



Now Therefore, Be it Resolved by the Council of the Village of Lakemore, County of Summit, and State of Ohio:


- Section 1: The Council approves the employment of Shawn McNulty as a full-time laborer with the Public Services Department.

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ORDINANCE NO 1686-2020

AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND ORDINANCE 1660-2019 "MAKE APPROPRIATIONS FOR CURRENT EXPENSES AND OTHER EXPENDITURES OF THE VILLAGE OF LAKEMORE, STATE OF OHIO. DURING THE FISCAL YEAR ENDING DECEMBER 31, 2020"

Now, Therefore, Be it Ordained by the Council of the Village of Lakemore, County of Summit, State of Ohio:


Section 1: Council approves to increase appropriations in:  
Water Enterprise Fund Professional Services \$10,000.00 to connect the water mains of Lake Road and Church Street

Section 2: Treasury for payments from any of the forgoing appropriations upon receiving proper certificates and vouchers therefore, approved by the board or officers authorized by law to approve the same, or an ordinance or resolution of Council to make the expenditures; provided that no warrants shall be drawn or paid for salaries or wages except to persons employed by authority of and in accordance with law or ordinance. It shall be provided further that the appropriations for contingencies can only be expended upon appeal of two-thirds vote of Council for items of expense constituting a legal obligation against the village for purposes other than those covered by other specific appropriations herein made.

Section 3: This Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the health, safety, and welfare of the citizens of the Village of Lakemore, Ohio. Therefore, this Ordinance shall go into effect immediately.
