

THE VILLAGE OF LAKEMORE
MINUTES FOR COUNCIL MEETING
AUGUST 17, 2020

Meeting Was Called to Order by Mayor Cole at 7:00 p.m.

Opening Roll Call: Mrs. Coontz, Mrs. Cochran, Ms. Snyder, Mr. Strittmatter, Ms. Anderson, and Mr. Douglas were present.

Pledge of Allegiance Was Led by Mayor Cole.

Motion to Accept minutes from August 3, 2020 council meeting as presented and not read was made by Mr. Strittmatter and seconded by Ms. Anderson. Roll call: Mrs. Cochran, Ms. Snyder, Mr. Strittmatter, Ms. Anderson, Mr. Douglas, and Mrs. Coontz voted “yes”. Motion carried.

Motion to Accept Purchase Orders from August 1, 2020 to August 16, 2020 totaling \$3,275.00 as presented and not read was made by Ms. Snyder and seconded by Mr. Strittmatter. Roll call: Ms. Snyder, Mr. Strittmatter, Ms. Anderson, Mr. Douglas, Mrs. Coontz, and Mrs. Cochran voted “yes”. Motion carried.

Motion to Accept Bills from July 28, 2020 to August 16, 2020, totaling \$99,655.56 as presented and not read was made by Mrs. Cochran and seconded by Mr. Strittmatter. Roll call: Mr. Strittmatter, Ms. Anderson, Mr. Douglas, Mrs. Coontz, Mrs. Cochran, and Ms. Snyder voted “yes”. Motion carried.

Mayor’s Report

Mr. Cole gave his thanks to Nancy Rodrigues and Springfield Cares for the backpack giveaway which was on Saturday, August 15, 2020

Mr. Cole Reminded everyone that Food Pantry is at 5pm the last Wednesday every month so will be held on August 26, 2020 this week.

Mr. Cole gave his thanks to Tracy Fast and council for the new guardrails and the streets that were paved.

Mr. Cole gave thanks to all the residents who’s tax revenue which helps the village afford such street repair

Council Report

Mrs. Coontz announced that the last day for lunches is on September 4, 2020 unless all the school moves to virtual learning

Mrs. Coontz announced that, until the 4th, free lunches are given out to the kids Monday through Friday from 11 till noon.

Mrs. Coontz gave a special thanks to Emory Pittman of the COPP for helping with passing out the lunches every day.

Mrs. Cochran announced that Saturday, August 22, 2020 is “Xavier’s Day” at Melanie Lake which is a fund raiser for medical expenses. There will be many vendors, baskets, food trucks etc.

Ms. Snyder announced that the next council meetings will be Tuesday, September 8, 2020 and Monday, September 21, 2020, both at 7:00 p.m. and at the Lakemore Municipal building.

Mr. Strittmatter announced that there is information on the villages website to help improve the health of the lake

Mr. Strittmatter announced that the last set of lake samples that were taken included Tracy Fast and himself. Samples were taken both directly from pipe in Lakemore as well as runoff at the water's edge in Springfield (rather than a known pipe). The results showed that the runoff in Springfield was approximately 4 times higher in E. Coli than that of Lakemore's pipe.

Ms. Strittmatter announced that there is more than one inlet to Springfield Lake and that it is not just the mine pipe at the point. There are at least 5 or 6 from Springfield Township.

Mr. Cole interjected to ask if there was wet weather sampling done on these other pipes.

Mr. Strittmatter explained that the Springfield resident who took samples, took them from the lake where ducks swim, not from pipe so they were subject to higher levels of E. Coli

Mr. Cole announced so only those samples for E. Coli showed results were not perfect on either side.

Mr. Strittmatter reminded everyone there is information on our website residents can use to improve the health of the lake and also to find any information for COVID assistance.

Mr. Strittmatter announced that he met with Springfield Township on August 1st to show some of Springfield residents where Springfield had pipes leading to the lake.

Ms. Anderson Announced that these test results are supposed to be published to Springfield Townships website.

Ms. Anderson announced that there is information on the village's for financial assistance for anyone that may need it.

Ms. Anderson announced that the next council workshops will be August 25th, September 16, and September 29th at 6:00 p.m. also at the Lakemore Municipal Building.

Ms. Anderson reminded everyone to mention Lakemore when renewing tags to ensure the Village receives permissive tax money to repair roads.

Ms. Anderson Reminded everyone to fill out their census as soon as possible.

Mr. Douglas announced his report on Ohio Future Foundation e.i. retail reductions so we will see reductions for need of business and industry

New Business

Ms. Snyder made a motion to dispense with the three readings of Resolution 6990-2020. Mr. Douglas seconded the motion. Roll call: Mr. Douglas, Mrs. Coontz, Mrs. Cochran, Ms. Snyder, Mr. Strittmatter and Ms. Anderson voted “yes”.

Motion carried.

Ms. Snyder made a motion to adopt Resolution 6990-2020. Mr. Douglas seconded the motion.

Ms. Fast mentioned the bid openings are Friday August 21, 2020.

Roll call: Mrs. Coontz, Mrs. Cochran, Ms. Snyder, Mr. Strittmatter, Ms. Anderson, and Mr. Douglas voted “yes”. Resolution Adopted

Mr. Strittmatter made a motion to dispense with the three readings of Resolution 6993-2020. Ms. Anderson seconded the motion. Roll call: Mrs. Cochran, Ms. Snyder, Mr. Strittmatter, Ms. Anderson, Mr. Douglas, and Mrs. Coontz voted “yes”. Motion Carried

Mr. Strittmatter made a motion to adopt Resolution 6993-2020. Mrs. Coontz seconded the motion.

Mr. Strittmatter mentioned that Mr. Tompkins only worked one day.

Roll call: Ms. Snyder, Mr. Strittmatter, Ms. Anderson, Mr. Douglas, Mrs. Coontz, and Mrs. Cochran voted “yes”. Resolution adopted.

Mr. Strittmatter made a motion to dispense with the three readings of Resolution 6994-2020. Ms. Anderson seconded the motion. Roll call: Mr. Strittmatter, Ms. Anderson, Mr. Douglas, Mrs. Coontz, Mrs. Cochran, and Ms. Snyder voted “yes”. Motion carried.

Mr. Strittmatter made a motion to adopt Resolution 6994-2020. Mrs. Cochran seconded the motion.

Ms. Anderson wishes him well.

Roll call: Ms. Anderson, Mr. Douglas, Mrs. Coontz, Mrs. Cochran, Ms. Snyder and Mr. Strittmatter voted "yes". Resolution adopted.

Ms. Anderson made a motion to dispense with the three readings of Ordinance 1686-2020. Ms. Anderson seconded the motion. Roll call: Mr. Douglas, Mrs. Coontz, Mrs. Cochran, Ms. Snyder, Mr. Strittmatter and Ms. Anderson voted "yes". Motion carried.


Mr. Strittmatter made a motion to adopt Ordinance 1686-2020. Mrs. Cochran seconded the motion.
