MINUTES FOR COUNCIL MEETING
SEPTEMBER 8, 2020

Meeting Called to Order by Mayor Cole at 7:03 p.m.

Opening Roll Call: Mrs. Coontz, Mrs. Cochran, Ms. Snyder, Mr. Strittmatter, Ms. Anderson, and Mr. Douglas were present.

Pledge of Allegiance was led by Mayor Cole.

Motion to Accept minutes from August 17, 2020 council meeting as presented and not read was made by Mr. Strittmatter and seconded by Mrs. Cochran. Roll call: Mrs. Cochran, Ms. Snyder, Mr. Strittmatter, Ms. Anderson, Mr. Douglas, and Mrs. Coontz voted "yes". Motion carried.

Motion to Accept Purchase Orders from August 18, 2020 to September 3, 2020, totaling \$43,833.00 as presented and not read was made by Mr. Strittmatter and seconded by Mrs. Cochran.
