WHEREAS, Springfield Township is seeking an alternative means of housing dogs until they are returned home or adopted beyond the services provided by Summit County, and

WHEREAS, the Village of Lakemore is able to provide alternative kennel services

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the Village of Lakemore, County of Summit, State of Ohio:

Section 1: The Mayor and Chief of Police are authorized to enter into an agreement to provide alternative kennel services to Springfield Township.

Section 2: The agreement is attached hereto and made part hereof as if fully rewritten herein.

Section 3: This resolution shall take effect on and after the earliest period allowed by law.



This Agreement is made the _____ day of _____ 2020 between Springfield Township and The Village of Lakemore, as related to the Lakemore Dog Kennels Located at 1400 Main Street, Lakemore, Ohio 44250.

Springfield Township hereby authorizes The Village of Lakemore Police Department (VLPD) to provide kenneling service for stray dogs that may be obtained from time to time in and around Springfield Township. Dogs brought in will be scanned for a chip and logged in by an officer of VLPD then placed in a kennel. Kellie Chapman shall be notified by text to 330-620-0639 so that she can start the process of locating owners. A picture of dog and a screenshot of login form shall be included in the transmittal to Kellie. Dogs will be held for three days (14 if chipped or tagged). At that time if owner does not come forward with in the allotted time VLPD and Kellie Chapman will endeavor to place the dog in a good home, fully- vetted. In the case of abuse or neglect, The Humane Society will be contacted and VLPD and Springfield Township Police endeavor to charge the owner/abuser.

Springfield Township agrees to pay \$25.00 per dog brought to the Lakemore Kennels, billed quarterly to Springfield township. This fee will be used cover kennel maintenance, food, and veterinarian and training when needed for the kenneled dogs.

The Lakemore Kennels shall provide facilities for the receipt and holding of stray dogs in addition to food and care. In the event the Lakemore kennels become full the obtaining officer will be directed to transport the dog to Summit County.

Either party may terminate this agreement at anytime with 30 days notice in writing and each party shall be under no further liability, one to the other. Should termination of this agreement occur, A final bill will be prepared and presented to Springfield Township for any dogs delivered to the Lakemore Kennels within the agreement period.

AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND ORDINANCE 1660-2019 "MAKE APPROPRIATIONS FOR CURRENT EXPENSES AND OTHER EXPENDITURES OF THE VILLAGE OF LAKEMORE, STATE OF OHIO. DURING THE FISCAL YEAR ENDING DECEMBER 31, 2020"

Now, Therefore, Be it Ordained by the Council of the Village of Lakemore, County of Summit, State of Ohio:

Section 1: Council approves to increase appropriations in:
Street Maintenance \$14,000.00 to afford 100 tons of road salt and new plow for truck #6

Section 2: Treasury for payments from any of the forgoing appropriations upon receiving proper certificates and vouchers therefore, approved by the board or officers authorized by law to approve the same, or an ordinance or resolution of Council to make the expenditures; provided that no warrants shall be drawn or paid for salaries or wages except to persons employed by authority of and in accordance with law or ordinance. It shall be provided further that the appropriations for contingencies can only be expended upon appeal of two-thirds vote of Council for items of expense constituting a legal obligation against the village for purposes other than those covered by other specific appropriations herein made.

Section 3: This Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the health, safety, and welfare of the citizens of the Village of Lakemore, Ohio. Therefore, this Ordinance shall go into effect immediately.
