
**A RESOLUTION ACCEPTING PERMANENT PARCEL NUMBER 5401597 FROM



RESOLUTION NO 6694-2017

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR AND FISCAL OFFICER TO APPLY FOR FUNDING FROM SERVE OHIO GRANT PROGRAM TO CREATE A DOG AREA AT HINTON HUMISTON WATERWORKS PARK

WHEREAS, ServeOhio is offering a “Global Youth Service Day” project grant to administer financial assistance to support projects that create or improve community assets or infrastructure, and

WHEREAS, the Village of Lakemore desires financial assistance under this grant program,

NOW, THEREFORE, be it resolved by the Council of the Village of Lakemore, County of Summit, State of Ohio:

Section 1: The grants support projects that create or improve community assets or infrastructure such as parks, schools, senior centers, community gardens or low-income homes through community volunteer engagement. Funds may be used for Supplies/materials and Volunteer Support.

Section 2: The Village of Lakemore will apply for \$888.92 to purchase supplies to create a designated area for dogs on April 22, 2017.

Section 3: This will be in collaboration with Lakemore Lions, youth civic organizations, and residents. The Village of Lakemore must provide initial funding for all project costs, and agree to submit copies of expenditures after-the-fact for reimbursement.


Section 4: If funded, the Village of Lakemore agrees to complete the project between April 21 and April 23, 2017. The Village of Lakemore will be required to complete a grant award agreement and register as a State of Ohio vendor. The Village of Lakemore will document their project by submitting a final project report, including photos and/or video no later than Friday, May 12, 2017.

Section 5: It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Resolution were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal action, were in

meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Codes.

Section 6: This Resolution is declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public health, safety and welfare of the citizens of the Village of Lakemore and for the purpose the grant application is due by March 7, 2017. Therefore, this Resolution shall take effect immediately.

PROCLAMATION

As representatives of the residents in the Village of Lakemore, Village of Lakemore Council is concerned for the health of the residents and supports September is Prostate Cancer Awareness month.

Whereas, Prostate cancer constitutes 19% of all cancer diagnoses and 8% of all cancer deaths; and

Whereas, In Ohio an estimated 5,840 new cases of prostate cancer and an estimated 1,020 deaths will occur; and

Whereas, Men with relatives – father, brother, son – with a history of prostate cancer are twice as likely to develop the disease; and

Whereas, Veterans are 1.5 times more likely to get prostate cancer; and


Whereas, Prostate cancer is most commonly diagnosed cancer in American Men and the third leading cause of cancer death behind lung and colon cancer; and

Whereas, this year approximately 161,360 men will be diagnosed with prostate cancer in the United States alone every year – that's one man every 3.3 minutes and roughly 26,730 die this year from the disease – which is one man every 20 minutes; and

Whereas, 1 in 8 men are diagnosed with prostate cancer. African American men are at the highest risk for the disease with a rate of 1 in 6 men. African American men are 2.3 times more likely to die from the disease; and
Whereas, Education regarding prostate cancer and early detection strategies is critical to saving lives, preserving, and protecting our families; and

Whereas, all men are at risk for prostate cancer and we encourage the citizens of the Village of Lakemore to increase the importance of prostate screenings.
