

Be it Resolved by the Council of the Village of Lakemore, Ohio:


- Section 1: Council authorizes the Mayor and Fire Chief to enter into a three-year memorandum of understanding with the American Red Cross Northeast Ohio Region.
- Section 2: This memorandum of understanding provides a broad framework for cooperation between the two organizations in conducting smoke alarm installations and fire safety education in the community.
- Section 3: A copy of this memorandum of understanding is attached hereto and made part of as if fully re-written herein.
- Section 4: This Resolution is declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public health, safety and welfare of the citizens of the Village of Lakemore therefore, this Resolution shall take effect immediately.

ORDINANCE NO 1574-2017

Dispense with Three Readings

AN ORDINANCE APPROVING THE AKRON CENTER ASSOCIATES'S L.P. PLAN OF LOTS
SUBDIVISION AS DEPICTED ON MYLAR PROJECT 161269 TO BE RECORDED, INCLUDING THE
SPARTAN TRAIL EASEMENT AND ROAD ACCESS EASEMENT AS DEPICTED THEREON

WHEREAS, AKRON CENTER ASSOCIATES (OWNER) and/or their designated representative have presented a plat subdividing certain property owned by them within the Village of Lakemore, Ohio; and

WHEREAS, the Planning Commission of the Village has approved such subdivision; and

WHEREAS, AKRON CENTER ASSOCIATES and/or their designated representative desire to grant easements in the Village of Lakemore, Ohio; and

WHEREAS, this Council deems that these easements would serve the interests of the Village,.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF LAKEMORE, STATE OF OHIO:

Section 1: Council approves easements presented by Akron Center Associates as depicted and set forth in the subdivision plat.


Section 2: Copies of these easements are attached hereto and made part hereof as if fully rewritten herein.

Section3: The Fiscal Officer is hereby authorized and directed to submit the approved mylar and a copy of this approved ordinance to the Summit County Fiscal Office to be recorded.

Section 4: It is hereby found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal actions were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with the law.


Section5: That this ordinance is necessary to provide for and to accomplish the purposes herein Set forth, which are conducive to the health, safety, and welfare of the citizens of the Village of Lakemore. For that reason, provided this ordinance shall receive the affirmative vote of three-fourths of the members of Council and approval by the Mayor, it shall be enacted immediately and shall be of immediate effect.


