Whereas, a clean environment is beneficial to the health and welfare of the citizens of the Village of Lakemore by asking volunteers to assist cleaning up the community from litter.


Be it Resolved by the Council of the Village of Lakemore, Ohio:



**Now Therefore, Be it Resolved by the Council of the Village of Lakemore, Ohio:**





Section 2: A copy of the agreement is attached hereto and made part hereof as if fully rewritten herein.



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A RESOLUTION SUPPORTING THE PARTICIPATION BY AKRON CENTER ASSOCIATES IN DEVELOPMENT OF THE SPARTAN TRAIL

Whereas, this Council desires to affirm its support for the development of the Spartan Trail, a hike and bike trail proposed to connect Springfield High School, the Waterworks Park and eventually, Springfield Lake to the North, which trail will promote quality of life for residents of the Village and Springfield Township;

Whereas, the proposed Spartan Trail will be constructed through property owned by the Village of Lakemore, within Hinton-Humiston Waterworks Park;

Whereas, it is proposed that the Spartan Trail be constructed through property owned by the Akron Center Associates, (the TriCounty Plaza) specifically along its West line and with a portion along its North line (to reach Canton Road). Addition of the trail on the TriCounty Plaza property will be incentive to further development of that property, including its vacant portions;

Whereas, this Council desires to encourage the Akron Center Associates to grant the easement necessary for development of portions of the Spartan Trail on its property

Now Therefore Be it Resolved by the Council of the Village of Lakemore, Ohio:


Section 1: The Village of Lakemore will provide an easement for the construction of the Spartan Trail through Hinton-Humiston Waterworks Park.

Section 2: Provided that Akron Center Associates grants the easement required for development of the Spartan Trail along the West line and North line of its property, the portion of its property granted shall still be counted toward as a part of the TriCounty Plaza property for all zoning purposes; including building and lot line set-offs and square footage requirements.

Section 3: The portion of the Akron Center Associates' property granted as easement for the Spartan Trail shall not be counted as an impervious surface..



**ORDINANCE NO. 1529-2015**

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**AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE 1526-2014 AN ORDINANCE TO MAKE APPROPRIATIONS FOR CURRENT EXPENSES AND OTHER EXPENDITURES OF THE VILLAGE OF LAKEMORE, STATE OF OHIO, DURING THE FISCAL YEAR ENDING DECEMBER 31, 2015.**

Be it Ordained by the Council of the Village of Lakemore, Ohio:

Section 1: The Council approves increasing revenue in Motor Vehicle Registration – Auto Muni and expenditures in Street Maintenance Other by \$15,379.62 to refund overpayment from Summit County.

Transfer \$18,010.00 from General Fund Transfers Out to General Fund Professional & Technical Services for Fire Department to afford 2015 dispatching services

Section 2: The appropriation adjustments will be made to afford expenses for 2015.

Section 3: And the Village Fiscal Officer is hereby authorized to draw warrants on the Village Treasury for payments from the foregoing appropriations upon receiving proper certificates and vouchers therefore, approved by the board or officers authorized by law to approve the same, or an ordinance or resolution of Council to make the expenditure. It shall be provided further that the appropriations for contingencies can only be expended upon appeal of two-thirds vote of Council for items of expense constituting a legal obligation against the Village and for purposes other than those covered by other specific appropriations herein made.

Section 4: This Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the health, safety and welfare of the citizens of the Village of Lakemore, Ohio, for the reason that the appropriations are necessary for the continued operation of the Village of Lakemore. Therefore, this Ordinance shall go into effect immediately.
