WHEREAS, the Village of Lakemore is due to renew services for a hosting company, and

WHEREAS, the Village of Lakemore is seeking a company that provides needed services at the best cost, and

WHEREAS, HostGator was found to provide the necessary services,

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the Village of Lakemore, County of Summit and State of Ohio:

SECTION 1. The Village of Lakemore will obtain services from HostGator to host the Village of Lakemore website and email system. Utilizing HostGator will eliminate the need to use Homestead as the hosting company and Network Solutions as the domain provider.

SECTION 2. The Village of Lakemore will opt for a three-year plan with HostGator at a cost of \$182.50 for the first year and \$34.94 per year thereafter.

SECTION 3. That it is hereby found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the passage of this resolution were adopted in an open meeting of this Council and that all deliberations of this Council or any of its committees that resulted in such formal actions were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements including Section 121.22 of Ohio Revised Code.

Now, Therefore, Be it Resolved by the Council of the Village of Lakemore, Ohio:




Section 3: No funds will be spent to train these employees, as they possess the necessary training already.



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**A RESOLUTION SUPPORTING THE PASSAGE OF ISSUE 8**

Whereas the Akron Summit County Public Library is a world class library system. However, it has suffered a 17% loss in annual revenue due to reduction in funding from the State of Ohio and local property tax valuation; As a result, the Akron – Summit County Library has proposed a renewal of its levy (expiring in 2015), with a half (1/2) mill increase in order to upgrade and expand its services. This levy proposal will be Issue 8 on the May 5<sup>th</sup>, 2015 ballot.

Whereas the Board of the Akron – Summit County Library has declared that with passage of Issue 8, there will be establishment of a temporary library branch for Springfield/Lakemore, and implementation of the plans for a permanent branch in our community.

Whereas, a library branch serving our community is greatly needed, for the benefit of our youth and all citizens.

Now, Therefore, Be it Resolved by the Council of the Village of Lakemore, Ohio:

Section 1: Council supports the passage of Issue 8 and urges all voters to vote for the Akron-Summit County's tax levy presented on the Ballot May 5, 2015.

Section 2: This Resolution is declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health, safety, convenience and welfare of the Village of Lakemore and the inhabitants thereof, and for the further reason that this Resolution must be forwarded to Akron Summit County Public Library committee before the upcoming election of May 5, 2015.



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**AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE 1526-2014 AN ORDINANCE TO MAKE APPROPRIATIONS FOR CURRENT EXPENSES AND OTHER EXPENDITURES OF THE VILLAGE OF LAKEMORE, STATE OF OHIO, DURING THE FISCAL YEAR ENDING DECEMBER 31, 2015.**

Be it Ordained by the Council of the Village of Lakemore, Ohio:

Section 1: The Council approves to re-appropriate \$150.00 to spend in EMS training 2901-160-348-0000.

Section 2: The appropriation adjustments will be made to afford expenses for 2015.


Section 3: And the Village Fiscal Officer is hereby authorized to draw warrants on the Village Treasury for payments from the foregoing appropriations upon receiving proper certificates and vouchers therefore, approved by the board or officers authorized by law to approve the same, or an ordinance or resolution of Council to make the expenditure. It shall be provided further that the appropriations for contingencies can only be expended upon appeal of two-thirds vote of Council for items of expense constituting a legal obligation against the Village and for purposes other than those covered by other specific appropriations herein made.

Section 4: This Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the health, safety and welfare of the citizens of the Village of Lakemore, Ohio, for the reason that the appropriations are necessary for the continued operation of the Village of Lakemore. Therefore, this Ordinance shall go into effect immediately.


