A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO FILE, ON BEHALF OF THE VILLAGE OF LAKEMORE, AN APPLICATION TO THE SUMMIT/AKRON SOLID WASTE MANAGEMENT AUTHORITY (DBA “ReWorks”) FOR COMMUNITY RECYCLING ACCESS GRANT

WHEREAS, the Village of Lakemore desires to assist in implementing and supporting new and existing community recycling programs that assist the Authority in meeting the goals and objectives of the State of Ohio’s Solid Waste Management Plan and the ReWorks’ approved Plan; and

WHEREAS, ReWorks has developed the Community Recycling Access Grant (the “Grant”) to support projects which would sustain and increase recycling activities within Summit County; and

WHEREAS, recommendation has been made to Lakemore Council that the Village of Lakemore apply to the ReWorks for the Grant which will further the goals to sustain and increase recycling activities within Summit County.

Now Therefore, Be it Resolved by the Council of the Village of Lakemore, Ohio:

Section 1: The Mayor is hereby authorized and directed, for and on behalf of the Village of Lakemore, to apply for the Grant in order to sustain and increase recycling activities within Summit County.

Section 2: The Village Fiscal Officer is hereby directed to send ReWorks a copy of this Resolution to the attention of Jenny Markovich, Program Coordinator, ReWorks, 12 East Exchange Street, Third Floor, Akron, OH 44308.

Section 3: That it is found and determined that all formal actions of the Village of Lakemore concerning and relating to the passage of this Resolution were adopted in an open meeting of the Village of Lakemore in compliance with all legal requirements including Sections 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

Be it Resolved by the Council of the Village of Lakemore, Ohio:


Section 1: That the week of April 21, 2014 through April 25, 2014 is hereby declared "Lakemore Clean-up Week" in the Village of Lakemore.



AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 1433- 2010
TO APPROVE THE AMENDED FINANCIAL RECOVERY PLAN AND FINANCIAL FORECAST
AS REQUIRED BY THE SECTION 118.06 OF THE OHIO REVISED CODE

Whereas, the Mayor must submit to the Financial Planning and Supervision Commission (“Commission”) an amended Financial Recovery Plan and Financial Forecast (“Plan”) as approved by Ordinance of the Village of Lakemore Council (“Council”);

Now, Therefore, be it Resolved by the Council of the Village of Lakemore, Ohio:

Section 1: The main objective of the Plan is to eliminate all fiscal emergency conditions which were determined by the Auditor of State pursuant to Section 118.04 of the Ohio Revised Code. The Plan will identify the actions to be taken by the Village to restore the fiscal integrity of the Village. It shall also serve as a plan by which all future appropriation measures must comply and shall direct the correction of the issues essential to financial recovery.


Section 2: Local Government Services (“LGS”) and Fiscal Officer amended the Plan in the same manner as its passage. The plan shall be reviewed by Council on a continual basis to ensure that the measures approved will in fact allow the Village to restore fiscal integrity.

Section 3: A copy of this amended Plan is attached hereto and made a part hereof as if fully rewritten herein.

Section 4: Upon approval of this amended Plan, a copy of this approved Ordinance and Plan will be submitted to the Commission for official approval.

Section 5: This Ordinance will take full force and effect on and after the earliest period allowed by law.




