A RESOLUTION TO PROMOTE NICHOLAS ALHASSANI TO FULL TIME
STATUS WITH THE LAKEMORE FIRE DEPARTMENT

Be it Resolved by the Council of the Village of Lakemore, Ohio:

Section 1: That the Council confirms the promotion of Nicholas Alhassani to Full Time Status with the Lakemore Fire Department, effective September 24, 2014.

Section 2: Nicholas Alhassani shall be eligible for all full-time health insurance benefits after a sixty (60) day probationary period. Mr. Alhassani's starting salary will be \$35,000.00 during his one-year probationary period. Mr. Alhassani's salary will then increase to \$36,000.00 thereafter.

Section 3: This Resolution and the promotion of employment of Nicholas Alhassani is hereby declared an emergency in the interest of the health, safety and welfare of the citizens of the Village of Lakemore and shall take effect and be in force on and after the earliest period allowed by law.



A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING AND DIRECTING THE MAYOR TO ENTER INTO THE AMENDED AGREEMENT OF COOPERATION WITH THE COUNTY OF SUMMIT FOR THE COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT BLOCK GRANT PROGRAM

Whereas, the Department of Housing and Urban Development funds projects with the primary objective to develop viable urban communities by providing decent housing and a suitable living environment and expanding economic opportunities, principally for persons of low and moderate income; and

Whereas, both the Village of Lakemore and the County of Summit created an agreement in 1993 to begin entering into community development activities with the County which are directed toward that primary objective; and

Whereas, with the upcoming, three-year renewal of the agreement, amendments directed from the Department of Housing and Urban Development are included and must be executed for requalification of funds.

Now, therefore, be it resolved by the Village of Lakemore, Ohio:

SECTION 1. That the Mayor, on behalf of the Village of Lakemore, Ohio, is hereby authorized and directed to enter into the amended agreement with the County of Summit for the Community Development Block Grant program.

SECTION 2: That a copy of the amended agreement is attached hereto and made a part hereof as if fully rewritten herein.

SECTION 3. That it is hereby found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the passage of this resolution were adopted in an open meeting of this Council and that all deliberations of this Council or any of its committees that resulted in such formal actions were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements including Section 121.22 of Ohio Revised Code.

SECTION 4. This Resolution is declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the health, safety and welfare of the citizens of the Village of Lakemore because there is a deadline for the execution of the agreement and amendment. Therefore, this Resolution shall take effect immediately.
