ORDINANCE NO 1786-2022

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE 1766-2022 “CHAPTER 942 SURFACE WATER MANAGEMENT DISTRICT OF THE CODIFIED ORDINANCES OF THE VILLAGE OF LAKEMORE, SUMMIT COUNTY, OHIO AND DECLARING IT AN EMERGENCY”

WHEREAS, on June 28, 2022, Summit County passed Resolution 2022-191 amending Chapter 942 of the Summit County Codified Ordinances; and

WHEREAS, Summit County Codified Ordinance Section 942.01, as amended, sets forth the purpose of the county wide Surface Water Management District to address water quality as required under phase II of the storm water program of the national pollutant discharge elimination system established in 40CFR Part 122; and

WHEREAS, Summit County Codified Ordinance Section 942.03, as amended, provides that a village or city may be included in the Service Area of the County’s Surface Water Management District by the filing of a duly authorized resolution of the legislative authority of the village, or city with the Clerk of County Council and the County Engineer;

WHEREAS, the Village of Lakemore had previously indicated its desire to join the Surface Water Management District before the passage of County Resolution 2022-191, which was reflected in Section 2 of Summit County Resolution 2022-191 and in Summit County Codified Ordinance Section 942.03; and

WHEREAS, the Village of Lakemore wishes to confirm its participation in the County’s Surface Water Management District pursuant to Summit County Codified Ordinance Section 942.03.

Now, Therefore, Be it Ordained by the Council of the Village of Lakemore, County of Summit, State of Ohio:

Section 1: Pursuant to Summit County Codified Ordinance Section 942.03, the Village of Lakemore requests participation in the Summit County Surface Water Management District understanding that the village will be bound by the provisions of Chapter 942 of the Summit County Codified Ordinances and regulations promulgated thereunder.

Section 2: A copy of this resolution shall be filed with the Clerk of County Council and the County Engineer.

Section 3: That it is found and determined that all formal actions of the Council relating to the adoption of this Ordinance were taken in a duly noticed virtual, open meeting of this Council and that all deliberations which resulted in formal action were taken in meetings open to the public, in full compliance with all applicable legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

Section 4: That this Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, safety, and welfare of the Village residents, for the immediate implementation of these rules, and provided this Ordinance receives the affirmative vote of the members elected or appointed to Council, it shall take effect and be enforced immediately upon its passage and approval by the Mayor.

ORDINANCE NO 1787-2022

AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND ORDINANCE 1743-2021 “MAKE APPROPRIATIONS FOR CURRENT EXPENSES AND OTHER EXPENDITURES OF THE VILLAGE OF LAKEMORE, STATE OF OHIO. DURING THE FISCAL YEAR ENDING DECEMBER 31, 2022”

Now, Therefore, Be it Ordained by the Council of the Village of Lakemore, County of Summit, State of Ohio:

Section 1: Council approves to increase appropriations in:
American Rescue Act Fund 2053 \$14,891.52 for operating supplies and materials for the Fire Department for the remainder of the year.

Section 2: Treasury for payments from any of the forgoing appropriations upon receiving proper certificates and vouchers therefore, approved by the board or officers authorized by law to approve the same, or an ordinance or resolution of Council to make the expenditures; provided that no warrants shall be drawn or paid for salaries or wages except to persons employed by authority of and in accordance with law or ordinance. It shall be provided further that the appropriations for contingencies can only be expended upon appeal of two-thirds vote of Council for items of expense constituting a legal obligation against the village for purposes other than those covered by other specific appropriations herein made.

Section 3: This Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the health, safety, and welfare of the citizens of the Village of Lakemore, Ohio. Therefore, this Ordinance shall go into effect immediately.
