AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND ORDINANCE 1152-1992 AND 1281-2000 ESTABLISHING
COMPENSATION FOR EMPLOYEES OF THE LAKEMORE POLICE DEPARTMENT FOR OFF-
DUTY SERVICES

WHEREAS, council desires to establish new rates of compensation for the employees of the Police Department of the Village of Lakemore, Summit County, Ohio.

Now, Therefore, Be it Ordained by the Council of the Village of Lakemore, County of Summit, State of Ohio:

Section 1: Council agrees to amend Ordinance 1152-1992 and Ordinance 1281-2000, section 1, subsections e, f, g and h hereby amended as follows:

- (e) Off-duty or secondary work performed by police officers for private persons or companies on special detail shall be at the rate of \$30 per hour per officer, paid by such private person or company directly to the officer.
- (f) Off-duty or secondary work performed by police officers for road details or construction details shall be \$30 per hour (paid by the vendor), with the exception of contract jobs where a prevailing wage exist, then the prevailing wage shall be the wage paid to officers, Prevailing wage shall not be less then \$30 per hour.
- (g) Off-duty or secondary work performed by police officers for funeral escort details shall be paid by the funeral home as follows:
 - Non-resident Decedent:** \$70 (\$50 for the officer and \$20 for the Village for use of the patrol car).
 - Resident:** \$50 (paid to the officer).
- (h) All officers working special details will be responsible for paying all federal, state, and local taxes and any other associated cost such as workman compensation and Medicare tax. While working any special detail if an officer has to take any police related action, at that point the officer is working for the Village of Lakemore Police Department and will be covered by all related benefits.

Section 2: All ordinances, resolutions and parts of ordinances and resolutions which are in conflict with this Ordinance are hereby repealed. Those ordinances, resolutions, and parts of ordinances and resolutions which are not in conflict with any provision of this Ordinance are hereby expressly excepted from repeal by this Ordinance and shall continue in full force and effect until otherwise amended or repealed by Council
