resolution shall take effect immediately.




A RESOLUTION APPROVING THE VILLAGE OF LAKEMORE TO APPLY FOR THE SERVEOHIO GLOBAL YOUTH SERVICE DATE GRANT TO PURCHASE AND PLANT SUNFLOWER SEEDS TO CREATE A FIELD OF FLOWERS IN VILLAGE OF LAKEMORE

Now Therefore, Be it Resolved by the Council of the Village of Lakemore, County of Summit, and State of Ohio:

Section 1: The Council approves the Village of Lakemore to apply for a grant of up to \$2000.00 from ServeOhio for Global Youth Service Day to purchase and plant sunflower seeds for upper Waterworks Park to create a field of flowers in Lakemore. This field of flowers will improve storm water run-off, positively impact water well system, and improve nature.

Section 2 : This Resolution is declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public health, safety, and welfare of the citizens of the Village of Lakemore, as the application is due by March 2, 2021. 

ORDINANCE NO 1703-2021

AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND ORDINANCE 1336-2003 "POLICIES AND PROCEDURES MANUAL"
AND AMENDING ORDINANCE 1523-2014 BY ALLOWING FULL-TIME EMPLOYEES TO SELL UP
TO 80 HOURS OF VACATION TIME ANNUALLY

Now, Therefore, Be it Ordained by the Council of the Village of Lakemore, County of Summit, State of Ohio:

Section 1: Council agrees to amend Ordinance 1336-2003 Section 6.05 VACATION TIME to include 7a. "A full-time employee may request payment of up to 80 hours of accrued vacation time each year without Council approval. This will only be paid after the employee's anniversary date."

Section 2: Council agrees to amend Ordinance 1523-2014 by changing Section 6.16 A.2. to read as follows: "No sick time or compensatory time shall be paid out to any officer or employee during employment".


Section 3: All ordinances, resolutions and parts of ordinances and resolutions which are in conflict with this Ordinance are hereby repealed. Those ordinances, resolutions, and parts of ordinances and resolutions which are not in conflict with any provision of this Ordinance are hereby expressly excepted from repeal by this Ordinance and shall continue in full force and effect until otherwise amended or repealed by Council

Section 4: That this Ordinance shall be in effect from and after the earliest period allowed by law.

ORDINANCE NO 1708-2021

AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND ORDINANCE 1669-2020 “MAKE APPROPRIATIONS FOR CURRENT EXPENSES AND OTHER EXPENDITURES OF THE VILLAGE OF LAKEMORE, STATE OF OHIO. DURING THE FISCAL YEAR ENDING DECEMBER 31, 2021”

Now, Therefore, Be it Ordained by the Council of the Village of Lakemore, County of Summit, State of Ohio:

- Section 1: Council approves to increase revenues \$7500 received in ERA/CRA Trust fund to afford any expenses related to Hidden Lake Estates Development
- Section 2: Council approves to increase appropriations in:
2052 Fire Grants \$15,000.00 to afford loading systems for squads
2901 EMS fund \$48,000.00 to afford loading systems for squads
General fund Buildings and Other Structures \$2400.00 for property taxes
- Section 3: Council approves to advance \$15,000.00 into Storm Water Utility until funds are received
- Section 4: Council approves the purchase order to Stryker Medical Division of \$57,281.82 for the two loading systems installed in each squad
- Section 5: Treasury for payments from any of the forgoing appropriations upon receiving proper certificates and vouchers therefore, approved by the board or officers authorized by law to approve the same, or an ordinance or resolution of Council to make the expenditures; provided that no warrants shall be drawn or paid for salaries or wages except to persons employed by authority of and in accordance with law or ordinance. It shall be provided further that the appropriations for contingencies can only be expended upon appeal of two-thirds vote of Council for items of expense constituting a legal obligation against the village for purposes other than those covered by other specific appropriations herein made.
- Section 5: This Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the health, safety, and

welfare of the citizens of the Village of Lakemore, Ohio. Therefore, this Ordinance shall go into effect immediately.
