AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND ORDINANCE 1743-2021 "MAKE APPROPRIATIONS FOR CURRENT EXPENSES AND OTHER EXPENDITURES OF THE VILLAGE OF LAKEMORE, STATE OF OHIO. DURING THE FISCAL YEAR ENDING DECEMBER 31, 2022"

Now, Therefore, Be it Ordained by the Council of the Village of Lakemore, County of Summit, State of Ohio:

Section 1: Council approves to increase appropriations in:
Street Construction, Maintenance and Repair Fund 2011 \$6,000 for Road Salt
Lakemore Fire/EMS Grant Fund 2052 \$6,000 for tools and equipment for the camera system for fire investigations. The full amount will be reimbursed by the South Summit Fire Chiefs Association.


Section 2: Council approves to make appropriations in:
Police Training Fund 2275 \$2,286.60 for Police Training

Section 3: Council approves to reallocate funds from:
American Rescue Act Fund 2053 \$7,898.64 from Police Salaries to Fire Operating Supplies and Materials for payment for the Stryker Lease Agreement

Section 4: Treasury for payments from any of the forgoing appropriations upon receiving proper certificates and vouchers therefore, approved by the board or officers authorized by law to approve the same, or an ordinance or resolution of Council to make the expenditures; provided that no warrants shall be drawn or paid for salaries or wages except to persons employed by authority of and in accordance with law or ordinance. It shall be provided further that the appropriations for contingencies can only be expended upon appeal of two-thirds vote of Council for items of expense constituting a legal obligation against the village for purposes other than those covered by other specific appropriations herein made.

Section 5: This Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the health, safety, and welfare of the citizens of the Village of Lakemore, Ohio. Therefore, this Ordinance shall go into effect immediately.
