A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO ENTER INTO A CONTRACT WITH THE SUMMIT COUNTY PUBLIC DEFENDER'S COMMISSION FOR DEFENSE OF INDIGENTS IN THE AKRON MUNICIPAL COURT FOR A PERIOD OF JANUARY 1, 2024, THROUGH DECEMBER 31, 2024

WHEREAS, the Village of Lakemore requires legal counsel in the Akron Municipal Court relative to the defense of indigent persons; and

WHEREAS, the Summit County Public Defender's Commission possesses the requisite qualifications needed to provide such services.

Now Therefore, Be it Resolved by the Council of the Village of Lakemore, County of Summit, and State of Ohio:

Section 1: The Mayor is hereby authorized to enter into a contract with the Summit County Public Defender's Commission for the defense of indigents in the City of Akron Municipal Court for the period of January 1, 2024 through December 31, 2024.

Section 2: The cost for such services shall be a sum not to exceed \$210.00 per case for 2024.

Section 3: The representation of indigent persons shall not exceed the fee schedule in effect and adopted by Summit County, Ohio.

Section 4: A copy of this contract is attached hereto and made part hereof as if fully re-written herein.

Section 5: A certified copy of this Resolution shall accompany the contract signed by the Mayor and shall be forwarded to the Summit County Public Defender's Commission.

Section 6: That it is hereby found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the passage of this resolution were adopted in an open meeting of this Council and that all deliberations of this Council or any of its committees that resulted in such formal actions were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND ORDINANCE 1795-2022 "MAKE APPROPRIATIONS FOR CURRENT EXPENSES AND OTHER EXPENDITURES OF THE VILLAGE OF LAKEMORE, STATE OF OHIO. DURING THE FISCAL YEAR ENDING DECEMBER 31, 2023"

Now, Therefore, Be it Ordained by the Council of the Village of Lakemore, County of Summit, State of Ohio:

Section 1: Council approves to increase appropriations in:
Street Construction, Maintenance and Repair Fund 2011 \$1,000 for Hammontree Services for the 2024 Road Paving
Emergency Medical Services Fund 2901 \$4,100 for Fire Salaries

Section 2: Treasury for payments from any of the forgoing appropriations upon receiving proper certificates and vouchers therefore, approved by the board or officers authorized by law to approve the same, or an ordinance or resolution of Council to make the expenditures; provided that no warrants shall be drawn or paid for salaries or wages except to persons employed by authority of and in accordance with law or ordinance. It shall be provided further that the appropriations for contingencies can only be expended upon appeal of two-thirds vote of Council for items of expense constituting a legal obligation against the village for purposes other than those covered by other specific appropriations herein made.

Section 3: This Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the health, safety, and welfare of the citizens of the Village of Lakemore, Ohio. Therefore, this Ordinance shall go into effect immediately.
