AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND ORDINANCE 0897-1978 TO MAKE WILSON STREET A TWO-WAY STREET FROM SANITARIUM ROAD TO ELMER STREET

AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND ORDINANCE 1743-2021 “MAKE APPROPRIATIONS FOR CURRENT EXPENSES AND OTHER EXPENDITURES OF THE VILLAGE OF LAKEMORE, STATE OF OHIO. DURING THE FISCAL YEAR ENDING DECEMBER 31, 2022”

Now, Therefore, Be it Ordained by the Council of the Village of Lakemore, County of Summit, State of Ohio:

- Section 1: Council approves to increase appropriations in:
General Medical/Hospitalization \$5,000 for Health Equity
Water Fund 5101 \$5,000 for Health Equity
Water Fund 5101 \$5,000 for fuel
Sanitary Sewer Fund 5201 \$25,000 for the EPA Fines and Orders
- Section 2: Council approves to increase revenues in:
General Fund Police \$136.12 from Young’s Auction Center
Fire/EMS Grants Fund 2052 \$4,720.54 from Summit County. They are reimbursing the Village for the fire investigation equipment.
- Section 3: Council approves to transfer funds from:
General Transfer Out \$24,272.01 to General Obligation Bond Retirement Fund 3101 for the interest payment to Huntington Bank for the interim financing.
- Section 4: Treasury for payments from any of the forgoing appropriations upon receiving proper certificates and vouchers therefore, approved by the board or officers authorized by law to approve the same, or an ordinance or resolution of Council to make the expenditures; provided that no warrants shall be drawn or paid for salaries or wages except to persons employed by authority of and in accordance with law or ordinance. It shall be provided further that the appropriations for contingencies can only be expended upon appeal of two-thirds vote of Council for items of expense constituting a legal obligation against the village for purposes other than those covered by other specific appropriations herein made.

Section 5: This Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the health, safety, and welfare of the citizens of the Village of Lakemore, Ohio. Therefore, this Ordinance shall go into effect immediately.
