LABORERS IN THE DEPARTMENT OF PUBLIC SERVICE TO EARN A CDL

Section 1: Council accepts to create an on the job training program for full-time laborers in
the Department of Public Service to earn a CDL.

Section 2: Candidates must follow the following for the program:

- Minimum requirements stated in the job description for the
Department of Public Service Laborer
- Complete the CDL Theory Training through ODOT LTAP on their
own time
- Complete Behind-the-Wheel and operating training during work
hours
- Complete all training and earn a CDL Class B within six months of
their start state. More time could be provided at the discretion of the
Village Administrator
- Pay for obtaining a temporary license and completing the state
required testing out-of-pocket
