AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND ORDINANCE 1770-2022 BY DECREASING THE LATE CHARGE

Now, Therefore, Be it Ordained by the Council of the Village of Lakemore, County of Summit, State of Ohio:

Section 1: Council agrees to amend Ordinance 1770-2022 by decreasing the late charge up to \$25 per month when the applicable payment is received after the due date on the 18th of the month after 4:30 p.m.

Section 2: The late charge will be assessed and disbursed into three service funds:
Sewer Fund \$15
Water Fund \$5
Trash Fund \$5

Section 3: All ordinances, resolutions and parts of ordinances and resolutions which are in conflict with this Ordinance are hereby repealed. Those ordinances, resolutions, and parts of ordinances and resolutions which are not in conflict with any provision of this Ordinance are hereby expressly excepted from repeal by this Ordinance and shall continue in full force and effect until otherwise amended or repealed by Council

Section 4: This Ordinance is declared to be an emergency measure in the interest of the health, peace, and safety of the citizens of the Village of Lakemore; therefore this Ordinance shall take effect immediately.

ORDINANCE NO 1778-2022

AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND ORDINANCE 1743-2021 "MAKE APPROPRIATIONS FOR CURRENT EXPENSES AND OTHER EXPENDITURES OF THE VILLAGE OF LAKEMORE, STATE OF OHIO. DURING THE FISCAL YEAR ENDING DECEMBER 31, 2022"

Now, Therefore, Be it Ordained by the Council of the Village of Lakemore, County of Summit, State of Ohio:

Section 1: Council approves to increase appropriations in:
General Fund Communications, Printing and Advertising \$5,000 for Legal Notices in the newspapers
General Fund Fire Professional and Technical Services \$3,244.99 for their portion of the radio system from Summit County
Fire/EMS Donation Fund 2903 \$1,000
Parks and Rec Donation Fund 2906 \$835.54 for park equipment
Sanitary Sewer Fund 5201 \$18,800 for Great Lakes RCAP to camera part of the trunk line
Storm Sewer Fund 5701 \$3,000 for Hammontree Services. These services were appropriated in 2021 and need to be reappropriated for 2022 to complete the payments for the project.

Section 2: Council approves to increase revenues in:
General Fund Police \$4,921.65 from Young's Auction Center
Fire/EMS Donation Fund 2903 \$1,000 from donation
Parks and Rec Donation Fund 2906 \$500.00 from donation

Section 3: Treasury for payments from any of the forgoing appropriations upon receiving proper certificates and vouchers therefore, approved by the board or officers authorized by law to approve the same, or an ordinance or resolution of Council to make the expenditures; provided that no warrants shall be drawn or paid for salaries or wages except to persons employed by authority of and in accordance with law or ordinance. It shall be provided further that the appropriations for contingencies can only be expended upon appeal of two-thirds vote of Council for items of expense constituting a legal obligation against the village for purposes other than those covered by other specific appropriations herein made.

Section 4: This Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the health, safety, and welfare of the citizens of the Village of Lakemore, Ohio. Therefore, this Ordinance shall go into effect immediately.
