AN ORDINANCE TO ADOPT THE AMENDED MUNICIPAL INCOME TAX PROVISIONS IN OHIO
HOUSE BILL 33

WHEREAS, on July 3, 2023 Governor DeWine signed House Bill 33, the state budget bill (the "Bill"), into law.

Now, Therefore, Be it Ordained by the Council of the Village of Lakemore, County of Summit, State of Ohio:

Section 1: Council agrees to adopt the amended municipal income tax provisions in Ohio House Bill 33.

Section 2: A copy of the amended municipal income tax provisions is attached hereto and incorporated herein as if fully rewritten.

Section 3: All ordinances, resolutions and parts of ordinances and resolutions which are in conflict with this Ordinance are hereby repealed. Those ordinances, resolutions, and parts of ordinances and resolutions which are not in conflict with any provision of this Ordinance are hereby expressly excepted from repeal by this Ordinance and shall continue in full force and effect until otherwise amended or repealed by Council

Section 4: This Ordinance is declared to be an emergency measure in the interest of the health, peace, and safety of the citizens of the Village of Lakemore; therefore this Ordinance shall take effect immediately.

ORDINANCE NO 1845-2024

AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND ORDINANCE 1833-2023 "MAKE APPROPRIATIONS FOR CURRENT EXPENSES AND OTHER EXPENDITURES OF THE VILLAGE OF LAKEMORE, STATE OF OHIO. DURING THE FISCAL YEAR ENDING DECEMBER 31, 2024"

Now, Therefore, Be it Ordained by the Council of the Village of Lakemore, County of Summit, State of Ohio:

Section 1: Council approves to increase appropriations in:
Street Construction, Maintenance, and Repair Fund 2011 \$46,607.60 for Perrin Asphalt Company for the 2023 Concrete Pavement Repair Program and Wenger Excavating Inc for the 6th, 7th, and Frank Street Project.
Permissive Motor Vehicle License Tax Fund 2101 \$30,000 for Perrin Asphalt Company for the 2023 Concrete Pavement Repair Program
Sewer Operating Fund 5201 \$50,000 for Wenger Excavating Inc for the 6th, 7th, and Frank Street Project

Section 2: Treasury for payments from any of the forgoing appropriations upon receiving proper certificates and vouchers therefore, approved by the board or officers authorized by law to approve the same, or an ordinance or resolution of Council to make the expenditures; provided that no warrants shall be drawn or paid for salaries or wages except to persons employed by authority of and in accordance with law or ordinance. It shall be provided further that the appropriations for contingencies can only be expended upon appeal of two-thirds vote of Council for items of expense constituting a legal obligation against the village for purposes other than those covered by other specific appropriations herein made.

Section 3: This Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the health, safety, and welfare of the citizens of the Village of Lakemore, Ohio. Therefore, this Ordinance shall go into effect immediately.
