Be it Resolved by the Council of the Village of Lakemore, Ohio:

- Section 1: Council hereby authorizes the amounts and rates as determined by the Budget Commission. Council authorizes the necessary tax levies and certify them to the Summit County Fiscal Officer.
- Section 2: A copy of the Tax Levy Certification is attached hereto and made part hereof as if fully rewritten herein. Council understands the Village of Lakemore's Official Certificate of Estimated Resources for 2022 will be sent prior to January 1, 2022.
- Section 3: It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the passage of this Resolution were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and any of its committees that resulted in such formal action, were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with the law
- Section 4: This resolution shall be in effect on and after the earliest period allowed by law.

Now, Therefore, Be it Ordained by the Council of the Village of Lakemore, County of Summit, State of Ohio:


Section 1: Council agrees to amend Ordinance 1336-2003 and Ordinance 1559-2016 Section 1.11 employee policies and procedures manual to adopt the updated Lakemore Police Department policies and procedures.

Section 2: A copy of the updated Lakemore Police Department policies and procedures is attached hereto and incorporated herein as if fully rewritten.

Section 3: All ordinances, resolutions and parts of ordinances and resolutions which are in conflict with this Ordinance are hereby repealed. Those ordinances, resolutions, and parts of ordinances and resolutions which are not in conflict with any provision of this Ordinance are hereby expressly excepted from repeal by this Ordinance and shall continue in full force and effect until otherwise amended or repealed by Council

Section 4: This Ordinance is declared to be an emergency measure in the interest of the health, peace, and safety of the citizens of the Village of Lakemore; therefore this Ordinance shall take effect immediately.

ORDINANCE NO 1734-2021

*Introduced by: Ms. Anderson
Dispense with the Three Readings*

AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND ORDINANCE 1696-2020 “MAKE APPROPRIATIONS FOR CURRENT EXPENSES AND OTHER EXPENDITURES OF THE VILLAGE OF LAKEMORE, STATE OF OHIO. DURING THE FISCAL YEAR ENDING DECEMBER 31, 2021”

Now, Therefore, Be it Ordained by the Council of the Village of Lakemore, County of Summit, State of Ohio:

- Section 1: Council approves to increase appropriations in:
Sewer Fund Payment to Another Political Subdivision \$100,000 for Akron Sewer Bill
Police Uniforms and Clothing \$20,081.88 for Body Armor (75% will be reimbursed from the grant)
- Section 2: Council approves to increase revenues in:
General Fund Intergovernmental \$15,061.41 from the Body Armor Grant
- Section 3: Treasury for payments from any of the forgoing appropriations upon receiving proper certificates and vouchers therefore, approved by the board or officers authorized by law to approve the same, or an ordinance or resolution of Council to make the expenditures; provided that no warrants shall be drawn or paid for salaries or wages except to persons employed by authority of and in accordance with law or ordinance. It shall be provided further that the appropriations for contingencies can only be expended upon appeal of two-thirds vote of Council for items of expense constituting a legal obligation against the village for purposes other than those covered by other specific appropriations herein made.
- Section 4: This Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the health, safety, and welfare of the citizens of the Village of Lakemore, Ohio. Therefore, this Ordinance shall go into effect immediately.
