A RESOLUTION APPROVING THE VILLAGE OF LAKEMORE POLICE DEPARTMENT TO
APPLY FOR THE OHIO BODY-WORN CAMERA GRANT PROGRAM 2023

Now Therefore, Be it Resolved by the Council of the Village of Lakemore, County of Summit, and State of Ohio:

Section 1: The Council approves the Village of Lakemore Police Department to apply for the Ohio Body-Worn Camera Grant Program 2023 from the Ohio Office of Criminal Justice Services. This grant helps to increase the use of body-worn cameras to serve a multitude of functions: to improve evidence collection, to train officers, to strengthen officer performance and accountability, to enhance agency transparency, and to document and investigate encounters between police and the public.

Section 2: The Village of Lakemore is requesting \$29,182.50 from the grant after a 10% match requirement of \$3,242.50 that the Village of Lakemore is responsible to pay.

Section 3: It is hereby found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Resolution were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal action, were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

Section 4 : This Resolution is declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public health, safety, and welfare of the citizens of the Village of Lakemore. Therefore, this Resolution shall be in full force and effect immediately upon its adoption and approval by the Mayor of the Village of Lakemore.

and State of Ohio:





ORDINANCE NO 1790-2022

AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND ORDINANCE 1743-2021 “MAKE APPROPRIATIONS FOR CURRENT EXPENSES AND OTHER EXPENDITURES OF THE VILLAGE OF LAKEMORE, STATE OF OHIO. DURING THE FISCAL YEAR ENDING DECEMBER 31, 2022”

Now, Therefore, Be it Ordained by the Council of the Village of Lakemore, County of Summit, State of Ohio:

Section 1: Council approves to increase appropriations in:
Sanitary Sewer Fund 5201 \$50,400 for Hammontree Services for the Sanitary Sewer Evaluation Study and 6” Force Main Replacement, and Ohio Edison for Electric Cost.

Section 2: Council approves to increase revenues in:
General Fund \$10,520.00 from Young’s Auction Center
Fire/EMS Grants Fund 2052 \$1,776.46 from Summit County for reimbursement for the Fire Investigation Equipment
Fire/EMS Donations Fund 2903 \$599.98 from the Lakemore Lion’s Club

Section 3: Treasury for payments from any of the forgoing appropriations upon receiving proper certificates and vouchers therefore, approved by the board or officers authorized by law to approve the same, or an ordinance or resolution of Council to make the expenditures; provided that no warrants shall be drawn or paid for salaries or wages except to persons employed by authority of and in accordance with law or ordinance. It shall be provided further that the appropriations for contingencies can only be expended upon appeal of two-thirds vote of Council for items of expense constituting a legal obligation against the village for purposes other than those covered by other specific appropriations herein made.

Section 4: This Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the health, safety, and welfare of the citizens of the Village of Lakemore, Ohio. Therefore, this Ordinance shall go into effect immediately.
