Now Therefore, Be it Resolved by the Council of the Village of Lakemore, County of Summit, and State of Ohio:


Section 1: Council approves to hire Jason Patrick Frankland as part-time police officer with the Lakemore Police Department.

ORDINANCE NO 1789-2022

*Introduced by: Ms. Anderson
Dispense with the Three Readings*

AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND ORDINANCE 1743-2021 "MAKE APPROPRIATIONS FOR CURRENT EXPENSES AND OTHER EXPENDITURES OF THE VILLAGE OF LAKEMORE, STATE OF OHIO. DURING THE FISCAL YEAR ENDING DECEMBER 31, 2022"

Now, Therefore, Be it Ordained by the Council of the Village of Lakemore, County of Summit, State of Ohio:

Section 1: Council approves to increase appropriations in:
General Fund Tax Collection Fees \$5,000 for the fees from the Regional Income Tax Agency
Sanitary Sewer Fund 5201 \$13,200 for Hammontree Services for the Sanitary Sewer Evaluation Survey

Section 2: Council approves to increase revenues in:
General Fund \$10,261.89 from the NOPEC Grant
Street Construction, Maintenance, and Repair Fund 2011 \$24,000 from OPWC for the Sanitarium/Ackers Road Project

Section 3: Treasury for payments from any of the forgoing appropriations upon receiving proper certificates and vouchers therefore, approved by the board or officers authorized by law to approve the same, or an ordinance or resolution of Council to make the expenditures; provided that no warrants shall be drawn or paid for salaries or wages except to persons employed by authority of and in accordance with law or ordinance. It shall be provided further that the appropriations for contingencies can only be expended upon appeal of two-thirds vote of Council for items of expense constituting a legal obligation against the village for purposes other than those covered by other specific appropriations herein made.

Section 4: This Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the health, safety, and welfare of the citizens of the Village of Lakemore, Ohio. Therefore, this Ordinance shall go into effect immediately.
