AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE 1101-1989 (KNOWN AS THE LAKEMORE ZONING ORDINANCE) BY CHANGING THE ZONING MAP DISTRICT OF ONE (1) PARCEL ON CANTON ROAD TO B-2 GENERAL BUSINESS DISTRICT

Now, Therefore, Be It Ordained by the Council of the Village of Lakemore, Ohio:

Section 1: That Ordinance 1101-1989 (Known as the Lakemore Zoning Ordinance) is hereby amended as set forth in this Ordinance.

Section 2: That the Zoning Map is amended indicating that parcels on Canton Road currently zoned B-1 are rezoned as B-2. The affected properties include:

<u>Parcel</u>	<u>Street Address</u>	<u>Property Owner</u>
54-02895	v/l Canton Road (rear)	Akron Center Associates LP

In addition, the Ordinance shall protect existing residential structures within the rezoned areas by requiring a built in “buffer” zone between future commercial buildings and existing residential properties. This “buffer” zone shall consist of dirt mounds, fences and/or foliage to protect said residential properties, to be placed along property lines. The Zoning Department for the Village of Lakemore shall determine exact height, width and material requirements.

Section 3: A map indicating the affected lots is attached hereto and incorporated herein as if fully rewritten.

Section 4: Any Ordinances or Resolutions or parts of Ordinances or Resolutions in conflict with this Ordinance are hereby repealed.

Section 5: This Ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.

AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND ORDINANCE NO 1605-2017“MAKE  
APPROPRIATIONS FOR CURRENT EXPENSES AND OTHER EXPENDITURES OF  
THE VILLAGE OF LAKEMORE, STATE OF OHIO, DURING THE FISCAL YEAR  
ENDING DECEMBER 31, 2018”

Be it Ordained by the Council of the Village of Lakemore, Ohio:

Section 1: Council approves to increase revenues in 4901 Capital Improvement State Funding Restricted \$113,000.00 that will be received by the Community Facilities Division of the U.S.D.A. The \$113,000.00 will comprise of a grant for \$39,000.00 and a loan for \$74,000.00.

Section 2: Council approves to increases appropriations in:  
4901 Capital Improvement Motor Vehicles \$113,000.00 to afford the remount of the 2008 Lifeline Type III Modular ambulance funded by the Community Facilities Division of the U.S.D.A.

Section 3: And the Village Fiscal Officer is hereby authorized to draw warrants on the Village Treasury for payments from any of the foregoing appropriations upon receiving proper certificates and vouchers therefore, approved by the board or officers authorized by law to approve the same, or an ordinance or resolution of council to make the expenditure; provided that no warrants shall be drawn or paid for salaries or wages except to persons employed by authority of and in accordance with law or ordinance. It shall be provided further that the appropriations for contingencies can only be expended upon appeal of two-thirds vote of Council for items of expense constituting a legal obligation against the village and for purposes other than those covered by other specific appropriations herein made.

Section 4: This Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the health, safety and welfare of the citizens of the Village of Lakemore, Ohio, for the reason that the appropriation is necessary for the continued operation of the Village of Lakemore. Therefore, this Ordinance shall go into effect immediately.
