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AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE 1252-1998 "AN ORDINANCE ADOPTING CONSTRUCTION AND MATERIAL SPECIFICATIONS AND STANDARD CONSTRUCTION DRAWINGS FOR ALL IMPROVEMENTS WITHIN ANY EXISTING OR PROPOSED VILLAGE OF LAKEMORE RIGHT OF WAY AND REPEALING ANY ORDINANCES INCONSISTENT"

WHEREAS, new standards in fire-fighting require additional equipment on every fire hydrant installed or replaced

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE VILLAGE OF LAKEMORE, OHIO, THAT:

Section 1: This Village Council approves to amend the Dry Barrel Fire Hydrants requirements to read:  
"Mueller Centurion Cat. No. A-423 with 6" mechanical joint inlet connection, 5 1/2" minimum main valve, one 4 1/2" pumper outlet having Akron Standard Fire Hose Threads and installing the Harrington Permanent Storz fitting HPHA hydrant adapter. This adapter HPHA consists of two primary parts, a Storz adapter and a Storz cap, connected together with aircraft cable to prevent loss of cap."

Section 2: All ordinances, resolutions, or parts of ordinances or resolutions inconsistent herewith are hereby repealed.

Section 3: This Ordinance is declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public health, safety, and welfare of the Village of Lakemore. Therefore, this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect immediately upon its adoption and approval by the Mayor of the Village.

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AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND ORDINANCE 1631-2018 “MAKE APPROPRIATIONS FOR CURRENT EXPENSES AND OTHER EXPENDITURES OF THE VILLAGE OF LAKEMORE, STATE OF OHIO. DURING THE FISCAL YEAR ENDING DECEMBER 31, 2019”

Now, Therefore, Be it Ordained by the Council of the Village of Lakemore County of Summit, State of Ohio:

Section 1: Council approves to increase appropriations in 1000 General fund for transfers out to: 2902 Nuisance Abatement \$6000 to afford work performed where grant was not received,  
4901 Capital Improvement \$211.21 to afford the difference for bond counsel for funding of ambulance, and  
4202 CDBG Construction \$16,204.55 to afford local match of the engineering of Lake Road and Fourth Street storm sewer project,  
1000 General fund \$300.00 for “Kennel Donations”

Section 2: Council approves to increase revenues in 2092 Nuisance Abatement \$6000,  
4901 Capital Improvement \$211.21,  
4202 CDBG Construction \$16,204.55, and  
1000 General fund \$6,361.66,  
1000 General fund \$300.00 for “Adoption Donations” 1000-820-0022

Section 3: Council approves to re-allocate appropriations in 1000 General fund \$300.00 from 1000-730-431-0000 “Kennel Donations” to 1000-110-340-0000 “Kennel Adoption Expenses”

Section 4: The Fiscal Officer is hereby authorized to draw warrants on the Village Treasury for payments from any of the forgoing appropriations upon receiving proper certificates and vouchers therefore, approved by the board or officers authorized by law to approve the same, or an ordinance or resolution of Council to make the expenditure; provided that no warrants shall be drawn or paid for salaries or wages except to persons employed by authority of an in accordance with law or ordinance. It shall be provided further that the appropriations for contingencies can only be expended upon appeal of two-thirds vote of Council for items of expense constituting a legal obligation against the village for purposes other than those covered by other specific appropriations herein made.

Section 5: This Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the health, safety, and welfare of the citizens of the Village of Lakemore, Ohio, for the reason that the appropriation is necessary for the continued operation of the Village of Lakemore. Therefore, this Ordinance shall go into effect immediately.
