AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND ORDINANCE 1336-2003 BY AUTHORIZING PERSONS
EMPLOYED BY THE LAKEMORE FIRE DEPARTMENT THE RIGHT TO WASH
PERSONALLY-OWNED VEHICLES

Now Therefore, Be it Resolved by the Council of the Village of Lakemore, Ohio:

- Section 1: Persons employed by the Lakemore Fire Department shall be legally granted the right to wash personally-owned vehicles within the Village of Lakemore Fire Department's Fire House. Under no circumstances shall an employee washing a personally-owned vehicle allow another person use of Village facilities to assist with washing an employee's personally-owned vehicle, nor shall any washing of a personally-owned vehicle interfere in any way with the full time and attention of all on duty employees of the Lakemore Fire Department.
- Section 2: This right shall be limited to twice each calendar month, or more often as may be necessary, if relating to additional work-related use of personally-owned vehicles when attending to local fire emergencies.
- Section 3: The related cost to exercise this right shall be \$1.00 per year per employee. Such amount shall be assessed as taxable earnings, and included on each employee's Form W-2 received annually.
- Section 4: Employees exercising this right shall be required to supply their own washing materials, including but not limited to, soap and paper and cloth towels.
- Section 5: Additional details relating to date and time restrictions for exercising this right shall be determined by the Chief of the Lakemore Fire Department.
- Section 6: This right shall be exercised only after such person employed by the Lakemore Fire Department has signed the Waiver of Liability attached hereto as Exhibit A.
- Section 7: That, except as amended herein, the existing provisions of Ordinance 1336-2003 shall remain in full force and effect.
- Section 8: This Resolution shall be in full force and effect on and after the earliest period allowed by law.

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO ENTER INTO A CONTRACT WITH SUMMIT COUNTY AND THE CITY OF AKRON TO REMAIN A USER IN THE SUMMIT COUNTY- AKRON REGIONAL RADIO SYSTEM

WHEREAS, the Village of Lakemore requires to partake in a county-wide regional radio system; and

WHEREAS, Summit County and the City of Akron provide such a communication system.

Now Therefore, Be it Resolved by the Council of the Village of Lakemore, County of Summit, and State of Ohio:

Section 1: The Mayor is hereby authorized to enter into a contract with Summit County and the City of Akron Municipal Court for the period commencing May 1, and will remain in effect for five years.

Section 2: As a user, the Village of Lakemore agrees to pay a membership fee of \$20.00 per month, per radio. The membership fee will be invoiced in advance on a semi-annual basis.

Section 3: A copy of this contract is attached hereto and made part hereof as if fully re-written herein.

Section 4: Three certified copies of this Resolution shall accompany the contract signed by the Mayor and shall be forwarded to the Summit County Division of Public Safety.

Section 5: This Resolution is shall take full force and effect on and after the earliest period allowed by law.





A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR AND VILLAGE SOLICITOR TO ENTER INTO AN AGREEMENT WITH THE CITY OF GREEN, OHIO FOR FIRE DISPATCHING SERVICES

Now Therefore, Be it Resolved by the Council of the Village of Lakemore, County of Summit, and State of Ohio:

- Section 1: That the Mayor and Village Solicitor are authorized to enter into an agreement with the City of Green, Ohio for Fire Dispatching Services. This agreement will be for a period commencing January 1, 2019, and ending December 31, 2019.
- Section 2: The City of Green, Ohio will provide emergency fire and medical dispatching service to Lakemore for calls which are received by the City of Green, Ohio which originate in the Village of Lakemore on a twenty-four (24) hour, seven (7) day-per-week basis.
- Section 3: A copy of this agreement is attached hereto and made part hereof as if fully rewritten herein.
- Section 4: This Resolution is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the health, safety, and welfare of the citizens of the Village of Lakemore, Ohio, as the service is necessary for the continued operation of the Village of Lakemore Fire Department. Therefore, this Resolution shall go into effect immediately.




