A RESOLUTION AMENDING RESOLUTION 6889-2019 "AUTHORIZING THE SUMMIT COUNTY FISCAL OFFICER TO CERTIFY TO THE VILLAGE OF LAKEMORE COUNCIL THE AMOUNT OF 2.5 MILL RENEWAL LEVY FOR THE LAKEMORE FIRE DEPARTMENT"

WHEREAS, The Village of Lakemore currently has a levy in place to benefit the Village of Lakemore Fire Department; and

WHEREAS, Council desires to renew this levy for five (5) years in the amount of 2.5 Mills to be levied upon the entire Village of Lakemore, which lies entirely within the Summit County, Ohio limits; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to law, prior to certifying such a levy to the Board of Elections for the voters' consideration, Council is required to request the County Fiscal Officer to certify the amount that a five (5) year, 2.5 mill renewal levy would yield to the Village Fire Department.

Now, Therefore, Be it Resolved by the Council of the Village of Lakemore, Summit County, Ohio:

- Section 1: Council hereby and herein requests, pursuant to O.R.C. 5705.03 (B), the County Fiscal Officer to certify the amount that a five (5) year, 2.5 mill renewal levy would yield to the Village's Fire Department. Such a levy is authorized by 5705.25 of the Ohio Revised Code and would be for the purpose of providing and maintaining a fire station and site thereof, fire apparatus and appliances, and ambulances and fire equipment; providing for the payment of permanent, part-time, or volunteer fire fighters and providing fire fighting, ambulance, paramedic and other emergency services. If approved, that tax would first be levied in 2020 for first collection in calendar year 2021.
- Section 2: That the Fiscal Officer hereby and herein directed to provide the County Fiscal Officer with a certified copy of the within Resolution so that certification required by law can be performed.
- Section 3: It is further resolved, that said current expense levy shall be submitted to the electors of the Village of Lakemore at the General Election on Tuesday, November 5, 2019.
- Section 4: This Resolution is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the peace, health, safety, and welfare of the citizens of the Village of Lakemore, therefore this resolution shall take effect immediately.

WHEREAS, The Village of Lakemore currently has a levy in place to benefit the Village of Lakemore Fire Department; and


WHEREAS, Council desires to renew this levy for five (5) years in the amount of 4.25 Mills and increase this levy 0.50 Mills to be levied upon the entire Village of Lakemore, which lies entirely within the Summit County, Ohio limits; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to law, prior to certifying such a levy to the Board of Elections for the voters' consideration, Council is required to request the County Fiscal Officer to certify the amount that a five (5) year, 4.25 mill renewal and increase of 0.50 mill levy would yield to the Village Fire Department.

Now, Therefore, Be it Resolved by the Council of the Village of Lakemore, Summit County, Ohio:

- Section 1: Council hereby and herein requests, pursuant to O.R.C. 5705.03 (B), the County Fiscal Officer to certify the amount that a five (5) year, 4.25 mill renewal and increase of 0.50 mill levy would yield to the Village's Fire Department. Such a levy is authorized by 5705.25 of the Ohio Revised Code and would be for the purpose of providing and maintaining a fire station and site thereof, fire apparatus and appliances, and ambulances and fire equipment; providing for the payment of permanent, part-time, or volunteer fire fighters and providing fire fighting, ambulance, paramedic and other emergency services. If approved, that tax would first be levied in 2020 for first collection in calendar year 2021.
- Section 2: That the Fiscal Officer hereby and herein directed to provide the County Fiscal Officer with a certified copy of the within Resolution so that certification required by law can be performed.


