PROCLAMATION

As representatives of the residents in the Village of Lakemore, Village of Lakemore Council is concerned for the health of the residents and supports Prostate Cancer Awareness month.

Whereas, one in seven men will get prostate cancer sometime in his lifetime; and

Whereas, Veterans are 1.5 times more likely to get prostate cancer; and

Whereas, prostate cancer is the most commonly diagnosed form of cancer and the second leading cause of cancer-related deaths among men; and

Whereas, every year approximately 180,890 men will be diagnosed with prostate cancer in the United States alone – that's one man every 2.9 minutes and roughly 26,120 die this year from the disease – which is one man every 20 minutes; and

Whereas, African American men are at the highest risk for the disease with a rate of one in four men. African American men are 2.5 times more likely to die from the disease; and

Whereas, Education regarding prostate cancer and early detection strategies are critical to saving lives and preserving and protecting our families; and

Whereas, all men are at risk for prostate cancer and we encourage the citizens of the Village of Lakemore to increase the importance of prostate screenings.

RESOLUTION NO 6648-2016

*Introduced by: Mayor Justice
Dispense with Three Readings*

A RESOLUTION OPPOSING THE CUTS TO THE PENSIONS OF PARTICIPANTS IN THE CENTRAL STATES PENSION FUND AUTHORIZED BY THE MULTIEMPLOYER PENSION REFORM ACT OF 2014, FOR THE COUNCIL, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, on December 16, 2014, the United States Congress passed the Multiemployer Pension Reform Act of 2014, which granted unprecedented authority to Trustees of underfunded multiemployer pension funds to make severe reductions to existing pensions, without any hearings or debates; and

WHEREAS, the Central State Pension Fund Trustees filed an application with the Department of Treasury to make cuts to retiree pensions in three tiers, ranging from 35 percent to 75 percent; and

WHEREAS, the Treasury Department has retained the services of Kenneth Feinberg to oversee this process, including holding public hearings across the Country to hear the concerns of those retirees that have been affected; and

WHEREAS, the Village of Lakemore has many retirees who depend on the Central States Pension Fund to provide food, housing, and a quality of life; and

WHEREAS, the loss of that income would devastate said retirees and their families throughout the Village of Lakemore; and

WHEREAS, this Council finds and determines, after reviewing all pertinent information, that it is necessary and in the best interest of the Village of Lakemore to oppose the cuts to the pensions of participants in the Central States Pension Fund authorized by the Multiemployer Pension Reform Act of 2014.


Now, Therefore, Be it Resolved by the Council of the Village of Lakemore, Ohio:

- Section 1: This Council opposes the cuts to the pensions of participants I the Central States Pension Fund authorized by the Multiemployer Pension Reform Act of 2014.
- Section 2: The Fiscal Officer is hereby authorized and directed to forward a copy of this Resolution to the Summit County delegation of the United States Senate, United States House of Representatives and Kenneth Feinberg.

Section 3: This Resolution is declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public health, safety and welfare of the citizens of the Village of Lakemore and for the purpose of immediately expressing opposition to the cuts before they go into effect on July 1, 2016.

Section 4: It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Resolution were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal action, were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Codes.


