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

Section 3: And the Village Fiscal Officer is hereby authorized to draw warrants on the Village Treasury for payments from any of the foregoing appropriations upon receiving proper certificates and vouchers therefore, approved by the board or officers authorized by law to approve the same, or an ordinance or resolution of council to make the expenditure; provided that no warrants shall be drawn or paid for salaries or wages except to persons employed by authority of and in accordance with law or ordinance. It shall be provided further that the appropriations for contingencies can only be expended upon appeal of two-thirds vote of Council for items of expense constituting a legal obligation against the village and for purposes other than those covered by other specific appropriations herein made.


Section 4: This Ordinance shall be in effect from and after the earliest period allowed by law.



ORDINANCE NO 1572-2016

Introduced by: Mr. Lance

**AN ORDINANCE REINSTATING A ONE HUNDRED PERCENT (100%)
RECIPROCITY CREDIT OF THE TAX ASSESSED BY THIS ORDINANCE**

WHEREAS, Ordinance 1458-2011 provided, among other things, that the Income Tax Credit Limit would be temporarily reduced until the Village of Lakemore met all regulatory requirements in Section 118 of the Ohio Revised Code and was released from Fiscal Emergency Designation by the State of Ohio;

WHEREAS, Ordinance 1539-2015 confirmed that upon release from the Fiscal Emergency Designation, Council will reinstate the one hundred percent (100%) reciprocity income tax credit;

WHEREAS, the Council of the Village of Lakemore was released from Fiscal Emergency on November 10, 2016;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF LAKEMORE, OHIO:

Section 1: The above recitals are incorporated by reference as if fully set forth herein and shall be as effective as if repeated verbatim.

Section 2: Council hereby reinstates the one hundred percent (100%) reciprocity income tax credit by amending Section 7: Reciprocity Provision: Credit for Tax Paid to Other Municipalities of Ordinance 675-1971 and Ordinance 963-1980 of the Village of Lakemore.


Section 3: The amended Section 7: Reciprocity Provision: Credit for Tax Paid to Other Municipalities shall read: Every individual taxpayer who resides in the Village of Lakemore, but who receives net profits, salaries, wages, commissions or other personal service compensation, for work done, or services performed or rendered outside of said Village, if it be made to appear that the taxpayer has paid a municipal income tax on such net profits, salary, wages, commissions or other compensation to another municipality, shall be allowed a credit against the tax imposed by this Ordinance of an amount so paid by the taxpayer, or on their behalf, to such other municipalities. The credit shall not exceed one hundred percent (100%) of the tax assessed by this Ordinance on such net profit, salary, wages, commissions or compensation earned in such other municipality or municipalities where such tax is paid.

Section 4: The Fiscal Officer is hereby directed to forward a copy of this Ordinance to the Regional Income Tax Agency immediately upon passage of the measure.

Section 5. All other Ordinances or Resolutions or parts of Ordinances or Resolutions inconsistent herewith are hereby repealed. All other Ordinances or Resolutions or parts of Ordinances or Resolutions not in conflict remain in full force and effect.




Be it Resolved by the Council of the Village of Lakemore, Ohio:

- Section 1: That the Mayor is authorized to enter into a contract with the Board of Trustees for Springfield Township for the provision of Police Services within the Village of Lakemore, pursuant to the attached contract to this Resolution and further in the performance of their duties pursuant to the attached contract that the Springfield Township Police Department, its agents and employees shall be cloaked with all of the Police Authority for the Village of Lakemore.
- Section 2: The total cost of the contract for 2017 is \$540,138.56. The monthly payment will be \$45,011.55 beginning January 2017.
- Section 3: A copy of the contract is attached hereto and made part hereof as if fully rewritten herein.
- Section 4: This Resolution shall take full force and effect on and after the earliest period allowed by law.


