
A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE FISCAL OFFICER TO TRANSFER UNCLAIMED MONIES FROM FUND NUMBER 9101 TO THE GENERAL FUND.

Be it Resolved by the Council of the Village of Lakemore, Ohio:

Section 1: The Fiscal Officer is hereby authorized to transfer monies totaling \$84,581.26 from Fund Number 9101 that have remained unclaimed for a period of five years from the date the warrant is transferred to the Unclaimed Monies Fund to the General Fund, pursuant to the policy established by Resolution No. 6340-2010.

Section 2: This Resolution shall take full force and effect on and after the earliest period allowed by law.





AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND ORDINANCE NO 1568-2016 "MAKE APPROPRIATIONS FOR CURRENT EXPENSES AND OTHER EXPENDITURES OF THE VILLAGE OF LAKEMORE, STATE OF OHIO, DURING THE FISCAL YEAR ENDING DECEMBER 31, 2017"

Be it Ordained by the Council of the Village of Lakemore, Ohio:

- Section 1: Council approves to increase the following appropriations:
Fund 5101 Water Enterprises Professional and Technical Services \$85,000.00
Fund 2904 Fire / EMS Operating Levy Training \$2442.66
Fund 2011 Street Construction, Maintenance, & Repair \$1475.00
- Section 2: Council approves to establish the appropriations and revenues for fund 2906 Parks & Recreation Donation at \$12,136.40
- Section 3: Council approves to increase revenues:
Fund 2904 Fire / EMS Operating Levy \$2442.66
Fund 2011 Street Construction, Maintenance, and Repair \$1475.00
- Section 4: And the Village Fiscal Officer is hereby authorized to draw warrants on the Village Treasury for payments from any of the foregoing appropriations upon receiving proper certificates and vouchers therefore, approved by the board or officers authorized by law to approve the same, or an ordinance or resolution of council to make the expenditure; provided that no warrants shall be drawn or paid for salaries or wages except to persons employed by authority of and in accordance with law or ordinance. It shall be provided further that the appropriations for contingencies can only be expended upon appeal of two-thirds vote of Council for items of expense constituting a legal obligation against the village and for purposes other than those covered by other specific appropriations herein made.
- Section 5: This Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the health, safety and welfare of the citizens of the Village of Lakemore, Ohio, for the reason that the appropriation is necessary for the continued operation of the Village of Lakemore. Therefore, this Ordinance shall go into effect immediately.
