Council Committee Reports

Mr. Timko announced the next Council workshop will be March 15th at 6:00 p.m.

Mr. Timko announced Council will hold public information sessions at 6:30 on March 20th, April 3rd, and April 17th just before council meetings regarding the income tax increase legislation proposed for the primary election of May 2nd.

Ms. Snyder reminded everyone she is holding her youth art workshops the second Tuesday of each month at the Lakemore Municipal Building from 5:00 until 6:30 p.m.

Ms. Snyder reported she attended the Steven Covey program at Springhill Elementary and reported the successful results.

Ms. Snyder reported results from a recent “Building Healthy Communities” meeting regarding the community garden. Expansion is planned for the site.

Mr. Cole reminded residents to mention they live in the Village of Lakemore when renewing annual registrations / tags to ensure we receive permissive and license money.

Mr. Cole announced the annual Egg hunt will be Saturday, April 8th at 1:00 p.m. at the upper waterworks park.

Mr. Cole announced the final Fellowship skating party for Springfield Lake Roller Rink will be Tuesday, March 14th.

Mr. Lance announced the annual “clean up Lakemore” day is Saturday, April 22nd at 9:00 a.m. Everyone will meet at the upper waterworks pavilion and return at noon for refreshments.

Mr. Lance reported the Lakemore Lion's club painted the interior of the Lakemore Police Department. He thanked the members for volunteering their Saturday to help the community.

Old Business


Mr. Lance made a motion to adopt Resolution 6686-2017. Mr. Timko seconded the motion. Mr. Lance explained the legislation must be approved so the City of Akron will continue to transport and treat the sanitary sewage. Although the new agreement does not consider the best interests of the Village of Lakemore, all master meter customers, engineers, and legal solicitors were involved with the completion of the best agreement for all involved. Knowing the upcoming rates increases for the next four years will allow the Village to create applicable rates to include capital improvement and other maintenance expenses.
