

The Village of Lakemore  
Minutes for Council Meeting  
March 21, 2016

**Meeting Called to Order** at 7:02 p.m.

**Opening Roll Call:** Ms. Snyder, Mrs. Coontz, Mr. Cole, Mr. Lance, and Mr. Timko were present.

**Pledge of Allegiance** led by Mayor Justice

**Moment of Silence for the Ray Family** was requested by Mayor Justice, to reflect on the loss of Ken Ray, Jr.

**Motion to Excuse Mrs. Cochran** was made by Mr. Cole and seconded by Ms. Snyder. Roll call: Ms. Coontz, Mr. Cole, Mr. Timko, and Ms. Snyder voted “yes”. Mr. Lance voted “no”. Motion carried.

**Motion to Accept Minutes of Council Meeting on March 7, 2016**, as presented and not read was made by Mr. Timko and seconded by Mr. Cole. Roll call: Mr. Cole, Mr. Lance, Mr. Timko, Ms. Snyder, and Mrs. Coontz voted “yes”. Motion carried.

**Motion to Accept Bills Presented by Fiscal Officer for \$59,838.32** as presented and not read was made by Mr. Lance and seconded by Mr. Timko. Roll call: Mr. Lance, Mr. Timko, Ms. Snyder, Mrs. Coontz, and Mr. Cole voted “yes”. Motion carried.

Mayor Justice reported the many improvements at Lakemore Plaza. There are only five vacant units; another may be leased soon.

Mayor Justice mentioned a national award was earned by JC Penney at Lakemore Plaza for meeting sales quotas. He congratulated the store and staff for the accomplishment.

Mayor Justice reported potential improvements to open the back entrance to Lakemore Plaza are currently being considered.

## **Council Committee Reports**

Ms. Snyder announced Art workshops are 2<sup>nd</sup> Tuesday of each month at 5:00 p.m.

Ms. Snyder announced she received a donation for art supplies.

Ms. Snyder reported she attended a meeting with the Summit County Health Department and a member from "Akron Grows" to determine a suitable location for a community garden.

Mr. Cole announced the next Council Workshops will be April 13<sup>th</sup> and April 26<sup>th</sup>.

Mr. Cole announced the Lakemore United Methodist Church will hold their monthly dinner on April 16<sup>th</sup>.

Mr. Cole reported the French toast breakfast at Springfield High School was a success. Proceeds will fund the purchase of AED units for the schools.

Mr. Lance announced the Village Egg Hunt will be Saturday, March 26<sup>th</sup> at Upper Waterworks Park.

Mr. Lance announced Clean up week will be April 17<sup>th</sup> through the 21<sup>st</sup>. He also mentioned "Clean up Lakemore" day will be Saturday, April 23<sup>rd</sup> at 9:00 a.m. Everyone will meet at upper Waterworks Park to break into groups to pick up litter throughout the community. Everyone will meet back at noon for refreshments.

Mr. Timko announced the next Council meetings will be April 4<sup>th</sup> and April 18, 2016 at 7:00 p.m.

Mr. Timko also reminded residents to mention they live in the Village of Lakemore when renewing licenses to ensure we receive permissive and license money.

## **Old Business**

Mrs. Coontz made a motion to adopt Ordinance 1542-2015. Motion was seconded by Mr. Cole.

Mrs. Coontz made a motion to amend Ordinance 1542-2015. Mr. Cole seconded the motion. The amendment in Section 5E1b is to read "Such enclosure shall comply with applicable Village setback restrictions for dog kennels". This will ensure the legislation correctly reflects the zoning code.


Mr. Cole made a motion to make two more amendments to the legislation. Mrs. Coontz seconded the motion. The amendment in Section 5E1b is to read “with or without person present.” The amendment in Section 5F is to read “as of the effective date hereof and between January 2 and January 31.”

Mayor Justice asked if there was any discussion.

Mr. Lance mentioned a great deal of time was spent on research and revisions. He thanked everyone for working so hard on it. He reminded everyone the reason why the legislation is needed is because of past incidents; guidelines and restrictions are needed for vicious animals. Mayor Justice reiterated his main concern is the safety of the community. He wants to make residents feel safe to live in Lakemore.

Roll call: Mrs. Coontz, Mr. Cole, Mr. Lance, Mr. Timko, and Ms. Snyder voted “yes”. Ordinance adopted as amended.

**Motion for Adjournment** was made by Mr. Lance and seconded by Ms. Snyder. Roll call: Mr. Cole, Mr. Lance, Mr. Timko, Ms. Snyder, and Mrs. Coontz voted “yes”. Meeting adjourned at 7:39 p.m.
