Minutes for Council Meeting
September 6, 2016

Meeting Called to Order at 7:00 p.m.

Opening Roll Call: Ms. Snyder, Mrs. Cochran, Mrs. Coontz, Mr. Cole, Mr. Lance, and Mr. Timko were present.

Pledge of Allegiance was led by Mr. Cole.

Motion to **Excuse** Mayor Justice was made by Mrs. Cochran and seconded by Mrs. Coontz. Roll call: Mrs. Cochran, Mrs. Coontz, Mr. Cole, Mr. Lance, Mr. Timko, and Ms. Snyder voted "yes". Motion carried.

Motion to **Accept Minutes of the Council Meeting on July 25, 2016**, as presented and not read was made by Mrs. Cochran and seconded by Mr. Timko. Roll call: Mrs. Coontz, Mr. Cole, Mr. Lance, Mr. Timko, Ms. Snyder, and Mrs. Cochran voted "yes". Motion carried.

Council Committee Reports

Mrs. Coontz announced the Lakemore Fire Department will hold their annual pancake breakfast on Saturday, October 29th from 9:00 a.m. until noon.

Mrs. Coontz reminded residents to mention they live in the Village of Lakemore when renewing licenses to ensure we receive permissive and license money.

Mrs. Cochran reported the annual Halloween party will be Saturday, October 29th from 1:00 until 3:00 p.m. at the Lakemore fire station. Donations are being accepted for the treat bags. Mrs. Cochran also reported the Springfield Police Auxiliary is seeking volunteers to join. She asked anyone interested to stop by the Springfield Police Department.

Ms. Snyder announced trick or treat will be Saturday, October 29th from 5:00 until 7:00 p.m. Ms. Snyder also announced she will start holding art workshops for kids the second Tuesday of each month at 5:00 p.m. at the Lakemore Municipal Building starting October 11th. The November art workshop will be the third Tuesday since the second Tuesday of November is Election Day.

Ms. Snyder also reminded everyone to vote on Election Day.

Mr. Cole announced the Lakemore United Methodist Church will have a swiss steak dinner on Saturday, September 17th from 4:00 p.m. until 6:30 p.m.

Mr. Cole also mentioned the Port Summit Rotary Club is a civic group vested in the community and excited to participate in community projects.

Mr. Lance announced the next Council meetings will be Monday, September 19th and October 3rd at 7:00 p.m.

Mr. Lance also announced the Lakemore Lions Club is seeking members. Their next meeting will be September 8, 2016 at 6:00 p.m. at the Lakemore United Methodist Church. Future meetings will be the second and fourth Tuesdays each month thereafter.

Mr. Timko announced the next Council workshop will be September 14, 2016 at 6:00 p.m. Mr. Timko also expressed excitement for the upcoming road improvements; hoping the weather does not delay anything.

Mr. Greg Welch stated to Council he was unhappy with the services provided by the Public Service Department regarding his water and sewer services. He expressed his belief that he was billed unfairly and differently than other customers. He admitted to forgetting to pay the bill but he does not believe the Village should disconnect services for delinquent bills, but contact those delinquent customers to remind them of their debt.

Mr. Welch reported a hole in front of 1458 Lake Road was a cause of his injury that spurred him to file a claim against the Village of Lakemore.

Mr. Welch stated he was told Mayor Justice contacted his landlord and requested he evict Mr. Welch from the property.

Mrs. Cochran stated Mr. Welch's time was expired. Mr. Cole thanked Mr. Welch for his appearance.




