

The Village of Lakemore  
Minutes for Council Meeting  
October 3, 2016

**Meeting Called to Order** at 7:00 p.m. by Mayor Justice.

**Opening Roll Call:** Ms. Snyder, Mrs. Cochran, Mr. Cole, Mr. Lance, and Mr. Timko were present.

**Pledge of Allegiance** was led by Mayor Justice.

Motion to excuse Mrs. Coontz was made by Mr. Lance and seconded by Mrs. Cochran. Roll call: Mrs. Cochran, Mr. Cole, Mr. Lance, Mr. Timko, and Ms. Snyder voted “yes”. Motion carried.

Motion to **Accept Minutes of the Council Meeting on September 19, 2016**, as presented and not read was made by Mr. Cole and seconded by Mrs. Cochran. Roll call: Mr. Cole, Mr. Lance, Mr. Timko, Ms. Snyder, and Mrs. Cochran voted “yes”. Motion carried.

Motion to **Accept Bills Presented by Fiscal Officer for \$53,843.94** as presented and not read was made by Mr. Timko and seconded by Mrs. Cochran. Mr. Lance asked about a bill paid to Becker Equipment. Ms. Fast explained the company provides supplies for the water system. Roll call: Mr. Lance, Mr. Timko, Ms. Snyder, Mrs. Cochran, and Mr. Cole voted “yes”. Motion carried.

Motion to **Accept August 2016 DOPS Delinquency Report** as presented and not read was made by Mr. Timko and seconded by Ms. Snyder. Roll call: Mr. Timko, Ms. Snyder, Mrs. Cochran, Mr. Cole, and Mr. Lance voted “yes”. Motion carried.

### **Mayor’s Report**

Mayor Justice announced the Iron Grill is hosting a fund raiser until October 19, 2016. Proceeds will fund a Springfield Spartan logo for the high-level water tower. Flyers for the fund raiser are available on Facebook, the Village website, and at the Lakemore Municipal building.

S&K Asphalt is estimating paving costs for more areas in the Village. Mohican Blvd is in need of major repairs where water lines were replaced.

The Edwin Shaw memorial ceremony will be hosted at Lakemore United Methodist Church before December 1, 2016. December 1, 2016, is slated as the first day of demolition of the cottages on Ambassador Drive.

### **Council Committee Reports**

Mr. Lance announced the Lakemore Fire Department will hold their annual pancake breakfast on Saturday, October 29<sup>th</sup> from 9:00 a.m. until noon.

Mr. Cole announced the Lakemore United Methodist Church will host a swiss steak dinner on Saturday, October 15<sup>th</sup> from 4:00 until 6:30 p.m.

Mr. Cole announced ServeOhio volunteer days are Saturday, October 22<sup>nd</sup> and Sunday, October 23<sup>rd</sup> at 1:00 p.m. Everyone will meet at Dodds Lakefront Park.

Mr. Cole announced Trick or treat will be Saturday, October 29<sup>th</sup> from 5:00 until 7:00 p.m.

Mrs. Cochran announced the annual Halloween party will be Saturday, October 29<sup>th</sup> from 1:00 until 3:00 p.m. at the Lakemore fire station. Donations are being accepted for the treat bags.

Mrs. Cochran reminded everyone Election Day is November 8<sup>th</sup>.

### **Appearing Before Council**

Ms. Judy Keister questioned the status of the zoning violations created by her neighbor. Mayor Justice explained the Village of Lakemore remains in litigation with her neighbor in question and has been advised not to pursue the violations until the court process is complete.

Ms. Keister stated her belief these violations are impacting the surrounding property values negatively. She requested the Village Solicitor attend the next Council meeting to the situation. Mayor Justice assured he would talk with the Solicitor, but nothing should be discussed in a public meeting while in litigation.

Ms. Darlene McCann expressed her unhappiness with the way the zoning violations and neighborhood problems have been handled. She asked Mayor Justice when her neighbor would be dealt. Mayor Justice explained the court cases were still in process, and he is hoping everything will be completed before the end of the year.


Mr. Bill Sullivan from SUPER Learning Center requested assistance from the Mayor and Council. His students need transportation for his vocational program. He wants to request a
