- Section 1: The Fire Chief is hereby authorized to apply for a joint grant from Assistance to Firefighters' grant program in cooperation with other fire departments in our region to purchase a Grace Fireground Accountability system.
- Section 2: This system will be used to remotely track all officers involved in a fire or other emergency situation.
- Section 3: This Resolution is declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public health, safety, and welfare of the citizens of the Village of Lakemore. Therefore, this Resolution shall be in full force and effect immediately upon its adoption and approval by the Mayor of the Village of Lakemore.



A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR AND FISCAL OFFICER TO APPLY FOR A FINANCIAL ASSISTANCE FROM THE OHIO E.P.A. TO AFFORD THE ASSET MANAGEMENT STUDY

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR AND FISCAL OFFICER TO APPLY FOR A GRANT FROM OHIO BUREAU OF WORKERS COMPENSATION TO AFFORD EXTRICATION EQUIPMENT AND A POST HOLE MACHINE

Now Therefore, Be it Resolved by the Council of the Village of Lakemore, County of Summit, and State of Ohio:

Section 1: The Mayor and Fiscal Officer are authorized to apply for a grant from the Ohio Bureau of Workers' Compensation to afford extrication equipment for the fire department and a post hole machine for the Department of Public Services.

AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND ORDINANCE 1336-2003 BY INCORPORATING A GENERAL  
POLICY REGARDING WORKPLACE SAFETY AND HEALTH

Ohio: Now, Therefore, Be it Ordained by the Council of the Village of Lakemore County of Summit, State of

Section 1: Sections 4.04 "Safety and Health" and 4.05 "Report of On-the-Job Injuries and Accidents" will be amended to incorporate recent requirements regarding workplace safety and health. These policy changes are attached hereto and made part of as if fully rewritten herein.

Section 2: A "First Report of an Injury, Occupational Disease or Death (FROI)" form must be completed by any injured worker.

Section 3: That, except as amended herein, the existing provisions of Ordinance 1336-2003 shall remain in full force and effect.

Section 4: This Ordinance shall go into effect on and after the earliest period allowed by law.
