MINUTES FOR COUNCIL MEETING
OCTOBER 1, 2018

Meeting Called to Order by Mayor Justice at 7:00 p.m.

Opening Roll Call: Mr. Ray, Mrs. Cochran, Ms. Snyder, Mr. Cole, Mr. Lance and Mr. Douglas were present.

Pledge of Allegiance was led by Mayor Justice.

Motion to Accept Minutes of the Council Meeting of September 17, 2018, as presented and not read was made by Mr. Cole and seconded by Mr. Ray. Roll call: Mrs. Cochran, Ms. Snyder, Mr. Cole, Mr. Lance, Mr. Douglas, and Mr. Ray voted “yes”. Motion carried.

Motion to Accept Purchase Orders Created in the Amount of \$39,239.35, as presented and not read was made by Mr. Ray and seconded by Ms. Snyder. Roll call: Ms. Snyder, Mr. Cole, Mr. Lance, Mr. Douglas, Mr. Ray, and Mrs. Cochran voted “yes”. Motion carried.

Motion to Accept Bills Paid in the Amount of \$161,723.59, as presented and not read was made by Mr. Lance and seconded by Mr. Ray. Roll call: Mr. Cole, Mr. Lance, Mr. Douglas, Mr. Ray, Mrs. Cochran, and Ms. Snyder voted “yes”. Motion carried.

Motion to Accept August 2018 Bank Reconciliation as presented and not read was made by Mrs. Cochran and seconded by Mr. Ray. Roll call: Mr. Lance, Mr. Douglas, Mr. Ray, Mrs. Cochran, Ms. Snyder, and Mr. Cole voted “yes”. Motion carried.

Motion to Accept September 2018 DOPS Delinquency Report as presented and not read was made by Ms. Snyder and seconded by Mrs. Cochran. Roll call: Mr. Douglas, Mr. Ray, Mrs. Cochran, Ms. Snyder, Mr. Cole, and Mr. Lance voted “yes”. Motion carried.

Mayors Report

Mayor Justice reported the Village will begin the third major project for 2018. The storm sewer system on Lake Road and Fourth Street will be improved with CDBG funding. This project will lead way to improving the storm systems on Second and Third Streets in the near future.

Council Report

Ms. Snyder announced the next Council workshops will be and Wednesday, October 10, 2018 and Tuesday, October 23rd at 6:00 p.m.

Mr. Cole announced the Lakemore Fire Department is selling Breast Cancer Awareness Shirts. 1 for \$20 and 2 for \$30.

Mr. Cole announced the Springfield Lakemore Chamber of Commerce Expo will be at Springfield High School Saturday, October 6th between 11:00 a.m. and 2:00 p.m. and invited all to attend.

Mr. Cole announced the Lakemore United Methodist Church will hold their next swiss steak dinner on Saturday, October 20th between 4:00 and 6:00 p.m.

Mr. Lance announced the Springfield girls basketball team will host “night at the races”.

Mr. Lance announced the Lakemore Fire Department Pancake Breakfast will be Saturday, October 27th between 8 am and noon. The Lakemore Halloween party will follow between 1 and 3 pm. Trick or treat will follow between 5 and 7 pm.

Mr. Douglas reported the Village continues to work on changing service providers for internet and phones for the municipal offices.

Department Head Reports

Chief Reinbolt announced the Ohio EPA has placed a ban on open burning because of the dry weather.

Chief Reinbolt reported the new squad is in service.

Chief Reinbolt announced the fire department received a grant from the Ohio Bureau of Workers' Compensation to purchase shields and gloves.

Appearing Before Council

Heidi Dressler of Summit County Health Dept asked all to complete a survey for park equipment installed at Dodds Lakefront Park.

Marti Davies announced she is hosting a "Taste of Akron" dinner at LUMC on November 10th between 5:00 and 7:00 p.m. Proceeds will benefit the Share a Christmas project. The Lakemore Lions club will provide desserts for the event. Tickets can be purchased from the Lakemore Police Department.

Old Business:

Mr. Lance made a motion to adopt Resolution 6820-2018. Mr. Cole seconded the motion.

Mr. Douglas made a motion to amend the legislation to require the Fire Chief, Fiscal Officer, and Mayor to review each account to approve or deny to forward for collections to the Ohio Attorney General's office. Mrs. Cochran seconded the motion. Chief Reinbolt explained the collection procedures would not change as they are practiced now. The Ohio Attorney General's office will have the ability to collect more delinquent EMS billing accounts than the current collection agency used after LifeForce has exhausted their collection abilities. Chief Reinbolt stated there was no reason to change the current collection procedure.

Roll call to vote on amending Resolution 6820-2018: Mr. Ray and Mr. Cole abstained from the vote. Mrs. Cochran and Mr. Lance voted "no". Ms. Snyder and Mr. Douglas voted "yes". Motion failed.

Roll on to adopt Resolution 6820-2018 as originally written: Mrs. Cochran, Ms. Snyder, Mr. Cole, Mr. Lance, and Mr. Ray voted “yes”. Mr. Douglas voted “no”. Resolution adopted.
