OCTOBER 7, 2019

**Meeting Called to Order** at 7:00 p.m. by Mayor Justice.

**Opening Roll Call:** Mr. Ray, Ms. Snyder, Mr. Strittmatter, and Mr. Douglas were present.

Mr. Douglas asked to Dispense with the Regular Order of Business so a new member of COPP could be sworn into position. Mr. Ray seconded the motion. Roll call: Mr. Douglas, Mr. Ray, Ms. Snyder, and Mr. Strittmatter voted “yes”. Motion carried.

**Mayor’s Report**

Mayor Justice complimented the many improvements to the parks. He thanked all who have initiated the work.

Mayor Justice explained Lakemore and Springfield have created a task force to improve the algae in Springfield Lake. He asked Mr. Ray and Mr. Strittmatter to elaborate on the status of the task force.

**Council Report**

Mr. Strittmatter explained the task force had met one time. The group agreed to research on the high influx of nutrients feeding the algae rather than chemically treating the lake.

Mr. Ray reiterated the algae growth is a problem everywhere. Public education is important. A scientist from Ohio State has agreed to assist with the research.

Ms. Snyder announced the next council meetings would be Monday, October 21<sup>st</sup> and November 4<sup>th</sup> both at 7:00 p.m. She also announced the next council workshops would be Wednesday, October 16<sup>th</sup> and Tuesday, October 29<sup>th</sup>.
