A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR AND POLICE CHIEF TO APPLY FOR FUNDING
FROM THE OHIO LAW ENFORCEMENT BODY ARMOR GRANT

WHEREAS, the Village of Lakemore Police Department is in need of body armor for the officers; and

WHEREAS, the State of Ohio Attorney General's Office is offering grant funding in cooperation with
OSHA to purchase body armor.

Now Therefore, Be it Resolved by the Council of the Village of Lakemore, County of
Summit, and State of Ohio:

Section 1: Council authorizes the Mayor and Police Chief to apply for funding from the Ohio
Attorney's Office and OSHA to receive grant funds to afford body armor for
officers of the Lakemore Police Department.

Section 2: This grant provides 75% of the cost to purchase body armor for law enforcement
agencies.

Section 3: This Resolution is declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the
immediate preservation of the public health, safety, and welfare of the citizens of
the Village of Lakemore. Therefore, this Resolution shall be in full force and effect
immediately upon its adoption and approval by the Mayor of the Village of
Lakemore.
